3. SETUP

3. **Connect Controllers:** Insert the included AA batteries into the wireless controllers. Press the Xbox Guide button on the controller to turn it on and connect to the console.
4. **Connect Headset:** Plug the wired headset into the controller for communication.
5. **Internet Connection:** The Xbox 360 features built-in 802.11n Wi-Fi for easy connection to Xbox LIVE. Navigate to network settings on the console to configure your wireless connection.
