## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BERG Buddy Jeep Junior is a robust and versatile pedal go-kart designed for children aged 3 to 8 years. It features a unique BFR system for easy braking, freewheeling, and reversing, an adjustable seat to accommodate growth, and a swing axle for enhanced stability on various terrains. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your go-kart.

## 2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

#### 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

# 3.1. BFR System (Brake, Freewheel, Reverse)

The BERG Buddy Jeep Junior is equipped with a BFR system, which integrates braking, freewheeling, and reversing functions into the pedal mechanism.

- Brake: To brake, simply pedal backward. This engages the coaster brake.
- Freewheel: When you stop pedaling forward, the go-kart will continue to roll without the pedals turning, similar to a bicycle.
- Reverse: After coming to a complete stop, continue pedaling backward to engage the reverse gear.




Image: Visual explanation of the BFR system, showing how pedaling backward activates the brake and reverse functions, and how freewheeling works.

## 3.2. Adjustable Seat

The seat of the BERG Buddy Jeep Junior is adjustable to accommodate children as they grow, ensuring comfortable and safe operation for users between 3 and 8 years old.

- To adjust the seat, locate the adjustment mechanism (typically a pin or lever) beneath the seat.
- Release the mechanism and slide the seat to the desired position.
- Ensure the mechanism is securely re-engaged before use. The child should be able to comfortably reach the pedals with a slight bend in their knees.

# 3.3. Swing Axle for Stability

#### 3.4. General Safety Guidelines

- · Always supervise children while they are operating the go-kart.
- Ensure the child wears appropriate safety gear, including a helmet.
- Operate the go-kart on flat, open surfaces, away from traffic, steep inclines, or water hazards.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 110 lbs (50 kg).
- Regularly check tire pressure and ensure all connections are secure before each use.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your BERG Buddy Jeep Junior.

- Cleaning: Clean the go-kart with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Tires:** Check the pneumatic tires regularly for proper inflation. Refer to the tire sidewall for recommended pressure. Inspect for wear or damage.

- Lubrication: Periodically lubricate moving parts such as the chain and axle bearings with a suitable lubricant, as specified in the assembly guide.
- Fasteners: Routinely check all bolts, nuts, and screws for tightness. Tighten any loose fasteners to prevent parts from detaching during use.
- Storage: Store the go-kart in a dry, sheltered area when not in use. The BERG Buddy Jeep Junior can be stored upright to save space.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your go-kart.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty pedaling	Low tire pressure, chain too tight/loose, obstruction in drivetrain.	Check tire pressure. Adjust chain tension as per assembly guide. Inspect for debris.
Steering feels loose or stiff	Loose steering components, lack of lubrication, bent steering rod.	Check and tighten all steering connections. Lubricate moving parts. Inspect for damage.
Go-kart pulls to one side	Uneven tire pressure, bent axle, misaligned steering.	Ensure tire pressures are equal. Inspect axles and steering for damage or misalignment.
BFR system not engaging properly	Drivetrain issue, internal mechanism fault.	Inspect chain and pedal mechanism for obstructions. If issue persists, contact customer support.
