2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your Smith Holt Helmet is engineered with advanced materials to protect your head during impacts. The outer shell is constructed from durable Polycarbonate (PC), and the inner material uses Expanded Polystyrene for effective shock absorption. Always ensure the helmet is properly fitted and free from damage before each use.

- **Proper Fit:** A helmet that is too loose or too tight may not provide adequate protection. Refer to the fitting instructions below.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect your helmet for any signs of cracks, dents, or wear to the shell, liner, or straps. If any damage is found, the helmet should be replaced immediately.
- **Impacts:** Even if there are no visible signs of damage, a helmet that has sustained a significant impact should be replaced, as its protective capabilities may be compromised.
- **Chemicals:** Avoid exposing the helmet to petroleum products, cleaning fluids, paints, or adhesives, as these can damage the helmet's materials without visible signs.

3. FITTING AND ADJUSTMENT

Achieving a correct fit is essential for the helmet's effectiveness. Follow these steps to ensure your Smith Holt Helmet fits securely and comfortably:

- 1. Measure Head Circumference:** Use a flexible tape measure to find the circumference of your head, just above your eyebrows and ears. Compare this measurement to the sizing chart below to select the appropriate helmet size.
- 2. Position the Helmet:** Place the helmet squarely on your head so that the front edge sits just above your eyebrows. It should not tilt back or forward.
- 3. Adjust Chin Strap:** Fasten the chin strap buckle. Adjust the straps so they form a 'V' shape under your ears. The strap should be snug but comfortable, allowing only one or two fingers to fit between your chin and the strap. The chin strap features a soft velvet piece to prevent rubbing or irritation in cold weather.
- 4. Check for Movement:** With the chin strap fastened, try to move the helmet from side to side and front to back. The skin on your forehead should move with the helmet, indicating a secure fit. The helmet should not slide independently.

4. FEATURES OVERVIEW

- **Cleaning the Shell:** Use only mild soap and water with a soft cloth to clean the exterior of the helmet. Harsh chemicals can degrade the helmet material.
- **Cleaning the Liner:** The removable liner can be hand-washed with mild soap and water. Allow it to air dry completely before reinserting it into the helmet.
- **Storage:** Store your helmet in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid storing it in places where it might be exposed to chemicals or solvents.
- **Transport:** When transporting your helmet, protect it from impacts and scratches by placing it in a helmet bag or a protective case.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Helmet feels too tight or too loose:** Re-check your head circumference against the sizing guide. Ensure the chin strap is adjusted correctly. If the helmet still does not fit properly, consider a different size.
- **Excessive sweating:** Ensure the helmet's vents are clear and not obstructed. The ventilation system is designed to help regulate temperature.
- **Goggle fogging:** Ensure your goggles are properly seated with the helmet to allow for optimal airflow between the helmet and goggle vents.
