PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Timex Expedition Rugged Core Analog Watch is designed for durability and reliable timekeeping. It features a classic analog display with a robust construction, making it suitable for various activities.

- Adjustable black 20mm resin strap for comfortable wear.
- Black dial with a date window at 3 o'clock, partial Arabic numerals, and 24-hour time markers.
- Durable black 43mm resin case with an acrylic lens.
- Indiglo light-up watch dial and luminous hands for visibility in low light conditions.
- Water resistant to 50 meters (165 feet), suitable for short periods of recreational swimming.

SETUP AND OPERATION

Setting Time and Date

The watch features a crown on the side for adjusting settings:

1. **Adjusting Date:** Gently pull the crown out to the first click position. Rotate the crown to set the desired date.
2. **Adjusting Time:** Pull the crown out to the second click position. Rotate the crown to set the correct hour and minute. Push the crown back in completely to start the watch.

Using Indiglo Backlight

The Timex Indiglo feature illuminates the entire watch dial for easy reading in the dark:

- To activate the Indiglo backlight, simply press the crown inwards. The dial will illuminate for a few seconds.

Understanding the Dial

The watch dial includes both standard 12-hour and 24-hour (military time) markers for versatile time reading:

- The outer ring displays standard 12-hour time (1-12).
- The inner ring displays 24-hour time (13-24), corresponding to the outer 12-hour markers.
- The bezel on the outside also features minute/second markers for precise timing.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch case and strap with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Water Resistance:** The watch is water resistant to 50 meters (165 feet). It is suitable for splashes, rain, and short periods of recreational swimming. It is NOT suitable for diving, snorkeling, or high-impact water sports. Do not operate the crown or pushers when the watch is wet.
- **Battery Replacement:** Battery life varies depending on usage. When the watch stops or the Indiglo light dims significantly, the battery may need replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure water resistance is maintained.
- **Storage:** Store the watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch not keeping accurate time or stopped.	Low battery or time not set correctly.	Replace battery (professional service recommended) or reset time using the crown.
Indiglo backlight is dim or not working.	Low battery.	Replace battery.
Date display is incorrect.	Date not set correctly or needs adjustment for month length.	Adjust the date using the crown's first click position.
