INTRODUCTION

The Bradley 198 is an exterior shelf-behind mirror or wall mounted towel dispenser designed for commercial and public restrooms. It is constructed from durable materials to withstand frequent use.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Important: Installation should be performed by qualified personnel in accordance with local building codes and regulations.

Tools Required:

- Drill
- Measuring Tape
- Level
- Screwdriver (Phillips or Flathead, depending on fasteners)
- Appropriate fasteners for wall material (not included)

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare Opening:** For recessed installation, create a rough-in opening in the wall or behind the mirror according to the dimensions provided in the product's technical data sheet. Ensure the opening is plumb and level.
2. **Position Dispenser:** Carefully insert the dispenser into the prepared opening. Ensure it is flush with the finished wall or mirror surface.
3. **Secure Dispenser:** Locate the mounting holes inside the dispenser. Using appropriate fasteners (e.g., screws, anchors) for your wall material, secure the dispenser firmly to the wall studs or blocking. Do not overtighten.
4. **Check Stability:** Verify that the dispenser is securely mounted and does not wobble.
5. **Load Towels:** Unlock the dispenser using the provided key. Insert the desired quantity of folded paper towels into the compartment. Close and lock the dispenser.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Loading Paper Towels:

1. Insert the key into the lock located on the top of the dispenser.
2. Turn the key to unlock the front panel or access door.

3. Open the panel/door to expose the towel compartment.
4. Place stacks of folded paper towels neatly into the compartment. Ensure they are aligned to prevent jamming.
5. Close the panel/door and turn the key to lock it securely.

Dispensing Towels:

Users can retrieve towels by pulling them from the dispensing slot at the bottom of the unit. The design allows for single-towel dispensing to reduce waste.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your Bradley 198 Towel Dispenser.

Cleaning:

- Clean the exterior surfaces regularly with a soft cloth and a mild, non-abrasive cleaner.
- For stainless steel, wipe in the direction of the grain to prevent streaking.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive pads, or steel wool, as these can damage the finish.
- Periodically wipe down the interior of the dispenser to remove dust or paper residue.

Refilling:

- Monitor towel levels regularly.
- Refill the dispenser before it is completely empty to ensure continuous service.
- Always use the correct type and size of folded paper towels as recommended by the manufacturer to prevent dispensing issues.

Lock Mechanism:

- Keep the lock mechanism clean and free of debris.
- If the lock becomes stiff, a small amount of graphite lubricant can be applied sparingly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Towels not dispensing smoothly	Incorrect towel type/size; towels jammed; dispenser overloaded.	Ensure correct folded towel type is used. Open dispenser and clear any jams. Do not overfill.
Dispenser door/panel not locking	Lock mechanism obstructed; key not fully inserted.	Check for debris in lock. Ensure key is fully inserted and turned correctly.
Dispenser loose on wall	Mounting fasteners loose or inadequate.	Tighten existing fasteners or replace with more appropriate fasteners for the wall material. Consult a professional if necessary.
