1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Verbatim Acclaim 1TB USB 2.0 Portable External Hard Drive (Model 97393) is a compact and high-capacity storage solution designed for convenient data backup and transfer. This device offers 1 terabyte of storage and connects via a standard USB 2.0 interface, ensuring broad compatibility with various computer systems.

Key Features:

- 1 TB storage capacity.
- USB 2.0 High-Speed connectivity (up to 480 Mb/s), backward compatible with USB 1.1.
- Compact and portable design.
- Compatible with Windows and Mac operating systems.
- Includes Nero BackItUp & Burn Essentials software for backup and restore functions.
- Includes a bonus Norton Online Backup (5GB) offer.
- Backed by a 7-year limited warranty.

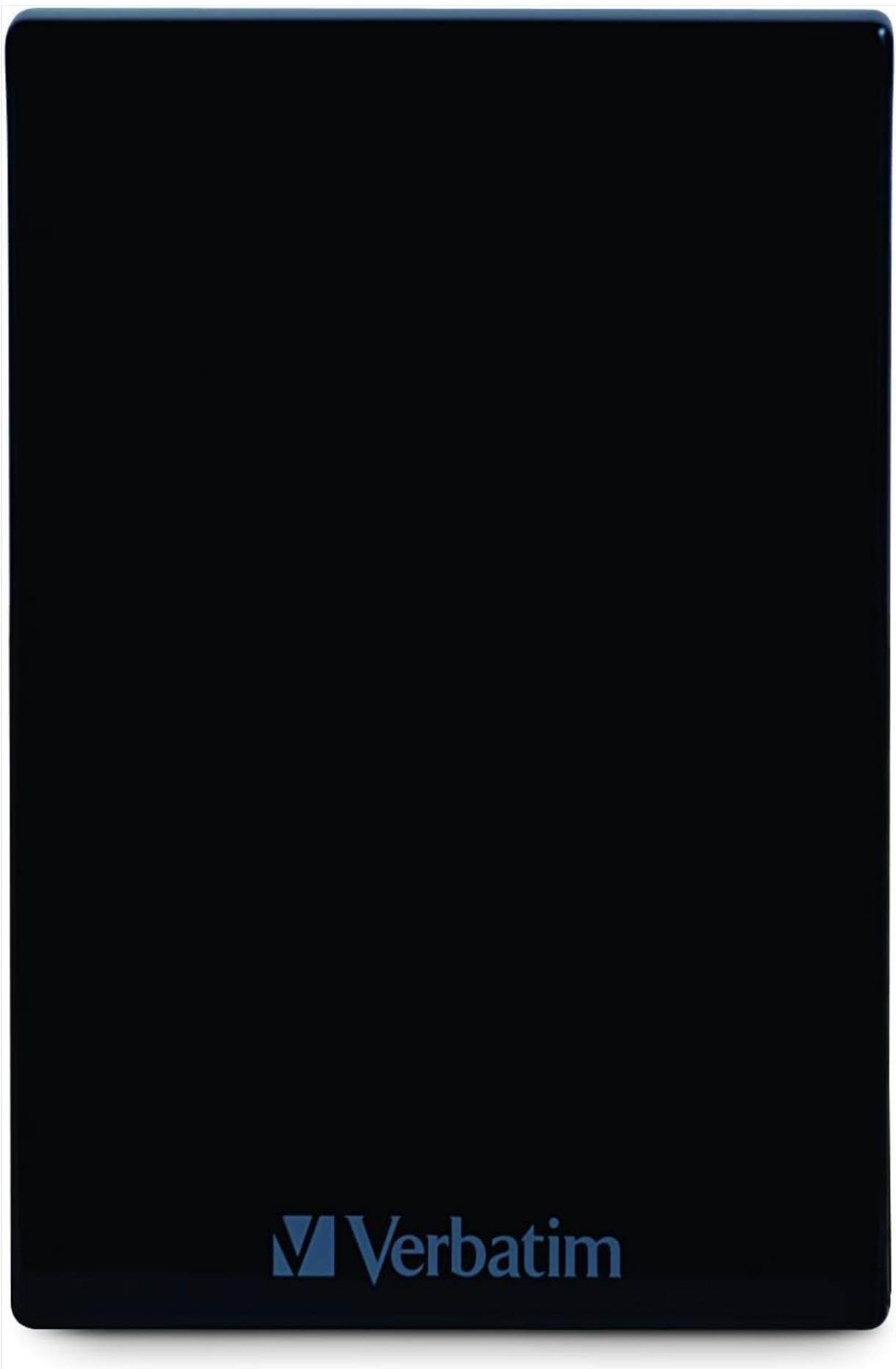


Figure 1.1: Top view of the Verbatim Acclaim 1TB portable hard drive. This image displays the device's sleek piano black finish and the prominent Verbatim logo, highlighting its compact and minimalist design.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

2.1. Connecting the Hard Drive

1. Locate an available USB port on your computer. The Verbatim Acclaim drive is compatible with both USB 2.0 and USB 1.1 ports. For optimal performance, use a USB 2.0 port.
2. Connect the small end of the provided USB cable to the USB port on the Verbatim Acclaim hard drive.
3. Connect the larger end of the USB cable to an available USB port on your computer.
4. The drive will automatically power on and be detected by your operating system. For Windows, drivers will typically install automatically. For Mac, the drive should appear on your desktop or in Finder.

2.2. Initial Formatting (Optional)

The drive comes pre-formatted, typically in FAT32, which is compatible with both Windows and Mac. However, FAT32 has a limitation on individual file size (maximum 4GB). If you plan to store files larger than 4GB (e.g., high-definition video files), it is recommended to reformat the drive to NTFS (for Windows) or HFS+ (for Mac).

Warning: Reformating the drive will erase all existing data. Ensure you back up any important files before proceeding.

For Windows:

1. Open "Disk Management" (Right-click "My Computer" or "This PC" > "Manage" > "Disk Management").
2. Locate the Verbatim Acclaim drive (it will be listed as a removable disk).
3. Right-click on the drive's partition and select "Format".
4. Choose "NTFS" as the file system and click "OK".

For Mac:

1. Open "Disk Utility" (Applications > Utilities > Disk Utility).
2. Select the Verbatim Acclaim drive from the sidebar.
3. Click the "Erase" tab.
4. Choose "Mac OS Extended (Journaled)" (HFS+) as the format and click "Erase".

2.3. Software Installation

The Verbatim Acclaim drive includes Nero BackItUp & Burn Essentials software and a bonus offer for Norton Online Backup. These software packages are typically located on the drive itself or can be downloaded from the Verbatim support website.

1. Access the drive's contents via "My Computer" / "This PC" (Windows) or Finder (Mac).
2. Locate the installer files for Nero BackItUp & Burn Essentials. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
3. Refer to the included documentation or the Verbatim website for details on activating the Norton Online

Backup offer.

3. OPERATING THE HARD DRIVE

3.1. Transferring Files

Once connected, the Verbatim Acclaim drive functions like any other external storage device.

- **Drag and Drop:** Simply drag files or folders from your computer to the drive's icon or an open folder on the drive.
- **Copy and Paste:** Right-click on files/folders on your computer, select "Copy," then navigate to the external drive, right-click in an empty area, and select "Paste."
- **Backup Software:** Utilize the included Nero BackItUp & Burn Essentials software for automated backups and system recovery.

3.2. Safely Removing the Drive

To prevent data corruption, always safely eject the hard drive before disconnecting it from your computer.

For Windows:

1. Click the "Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media" icon in the system tray (bottom-right corner).
2. Select the Verbatim Acclaim drive from the list.
3. Wait for the "Safe to Remove Hardware" notification before disconnecting the USB cable.

For Mac:

1. Drag the drive's icon from your desktop to the Trash icon in the Dock (the Trash icon will change to an Eject icon).
2. Alternatively, right-click (or Control-click) the drive icon on the desktop and select "Eject [Drive Name]".
3. Wait for the drive icon to disappear from your desktop before disconnecting the USB cable.

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and reliable performance of your Verbatim Acclaim hard drive.

- **Physical Care:** Handle the drive with care. Avoid dropping it or exposing it to excessive shock, as this can damage the internal components.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the exterior of the drive. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Temperature and Environment:** Store and operate the drive in a cool, dry environment, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Regular Backups:** While the Acclaim drive is excellent for storing data, it is crucial to maintain multiple copies of important files. No single storage device is infallible.
- **Safe Ejection:** Always follow the safe removal procedures outlined in Section 3.2 to prevent data corruption.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Verbatim Acclaim hard drive, try the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Drive Not Detected:**
 - Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the drive and the computer.
 - Try connecting the drive to a different USB port on your computer.
 - Test the drive with a different USB cable, if available.
 - Restart your computer and try connecting the drive again.
- **Slow Data Transfer:**
 - Ensure you are connected to a USB 2.0 port for optimal speed. USB 1.1 ports will result in significantly slower transfers.
 - Close any unnecessary applications running in the background that might be consuming system resources.
 - Check your computer's disk for errors or fragmentation.
- **File System Errors / Drive Unresponsive:**
 - Always safely eject the drive before disconnecting. Abrupt disconnection can lead to file system corruption.
 - Run a disk check utility (e.g., "Error Checking" in Windows or "First Aid" in Disk Utility on Mac) to scan

and repair minor file system errors.

- If errors persist and data is backed up, consider reformatting the drive as described in Section 2.2.

- **Drive Gets Warm:**

It is normal for the drive to generate some heat during operation, especially during prolonged data transfers. Ensure adequate airflow around the device.
