OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

residue is removed before next use.

- Glass Door: Clean the glass door with a glass cleaner or warm soapy water. Avoid abrasive materials that could scratch the glass.
- Racks and Accessories: Wash racks and trays in warm soapy water or in a dishwasher if suitable.

Do not use steam cleaners or high-pressure cleaning devices on the oven.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your oven, refer to the following common problems and solutions before contacting service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not heat up.	No power supply; oven not turned on; fuse blown.	Check power connection; ensure knobs are set to a function and temperature; check household fuse/circuit breaker.
Digital display is blank.	No power supply.	Check power connection and fuse/circuit breaker.
Food is not cooking evenly.	Incorrect temperature setting; improper rack position; oven door not fully closed.	Verify temperature setting; use recommended rack position; ensure door is sealed.
Oven light not working.	Light bulb needs replacement.	Refer to the full manual for instructions on replacing the oven light bulb.
