SETUP AND PREPARATION

The SOLO X16N-J8002 cups are designed for immediate use upon unpacking. No assembly is required.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the cups from their packaging. Inspect for any damage during transit.
2. **Storage:** Store cups in a clean, dry environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to maintain their integrity.
3. **Lids (Optional):** If using coordinating lids (sold separately), ensure they are compatible with the 16 oz Trophy Plus cup size for a secure fit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

These cups are versatile for both hot and cold beverages.

For Hot Beverages:

- Pour hot liquids directly into the cup. The insulated foam construction helps maintain beverage temperature and keeps the exterior comfortable to touch.
- Ensure the beverage temperature does not exceed safe handling limits for foam products.
- If using a lid, press it firmly onto the rolled rim of the cup to create a seal.

For Cold Beverages:

- Fill the cup with cold liquids or ice. The insulation helps reduce condensation on the exterior.
- If using a lid, press it firmly onto the rolled rim of the cup to create a seal.

MAINTENANCE AND DISPOSAL

These cups are designed for single-use applications.

- **Cleaning:** Do not attempt to wash or reuse these cups. They are intended for one-time use only.
- **Disposal:** Dispose of used cups in accordance with local waste management regulations.

TROUBLESHOOTING

While these cups are simple in design, here are common inquiries:

- **Lid does not fit securely:** Ensure you are using a lid specifically designed for 16 oz Trophy Plus cups. Lids are sold separately and compatibility is crucial for a proper seal.

- **Cup feels too hot/cold:** The insulated foam is designed to maintain beverage temperature and provide a comfortable grip. Extreme temperatures of contents may still affect the cup's exterior. Always handle with care.
- **Leaking:** Check for any visible damage to the cup or rim. Ensure the lid (if used) is properly seated. These cups feature a rolled rim for structural rigidity and resistance to leaking when fitted with a compatible lid.






