INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of the Makita 837645-9 Makpac Moulded Inlay. This inlay is designed to securely hold specific Makita impact wrenches within a compatible Makpac connector case, enhancing organization and transport efficiency.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Material:** Constructed from durable plastic for long-lasting use.
- **Compatibility:** Specifically designed for Makita DTW450, DTW1001, and DTW1002 impact wrenches.
- **Organization:** Provides a custom-fit compartment to prevent tools from shifting during transport.
- **Integration:** Designed to fit seamlessly into a Makita Makpac Type 3 connector case (case not included).

COMPATIBILITY

The Makita 837645-9 Moulded Inlay is engineered for use with the following Makita impact wrench models:

- Makita DTW450
- Makita DTW1001
- Makita DTW1002

This inlay requires a Makita Makpac Type 3 connector case for proper installation and use. The Makpac case is sold separately.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Prepare the Makpac Case:** Open your Makita Makpac Type 3 connector case. Ensure the case is clean and free of debris.
2. **Insert the Inlay:** Carefully place the Makita 837645-9 moulded inlay into the bottom section of the Makpac Type 3 case. The inlay is designed to fit snugly.
3. **Position the Tool:** Place your compatible Makita impact wrench (DTW450, DTW1001, or DTW1002) into the designated cavity within the inlay. Ensure the tool sits securely and does not move excessively.
4. **Close the Case:** Close the Makpac case lid and secure the latches. The inlay and tool should be held firmly in place.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Makita 837645-9 Moulded Inlay functions as a storage and transport solution. Its operation is

straightforward:

- Always ensure your impact wrench is properly seated within the inlay before closing the Makpac case.
- Verify that the Makpac case latches are securely fastened to prevent accidental opening during transport.
- When stacking multiple Makpac cases, ensure they are correctly interlocked using the integrated latches for stable transport.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the inlay with a damp cloth to remove dust, dirt, or debris. For stubborn grime, a mild soap solution can be used. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the plastic.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the inlay for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage. If significant damage is observed, consider replacing the inlay to ensure proper tool protection.
- **Storage:** Store the inlay in a dry environment, away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures, when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Makita 837645-9 Makpac Moulded Inlay, consider the following:

- **Inlay Does Not Fit in Case:** Ensure you are using a Makita Makpac Type 3 connector case. This

inlay is specifically designed for this case type.

- **Tool Does Not Fit in Inlay:** Verify that your impact wrench is one of the compatible models: DTW450, DTW1001, or DTW1002. Other models may not fit correctly.
- **Inlay or Case Damage:** If the inlay or case is damaged, it may compromise the security of your tool. Replace damaged components as necessary.
