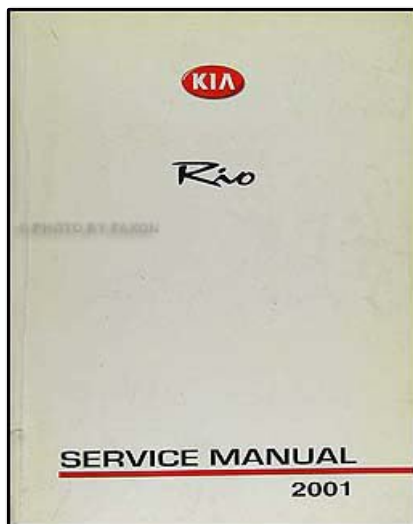

### Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)

### Scheduled Maintenance Chart

Service Item	Interval (Miles / Months)	Action
Engine Oil & Filter	3,000 / 3	Replace
Tire Rotation	6,000 / 6	Rotate and Inspect
Air Filter	12,000 / 12	Inspect / Replace as needed
Spark Plugs	30,000 / 30	Replace
Timing Belt	60,000 / 60	Inspect / Replace as needed

## TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section provides diagnostic steps for common operational problems encountered with the 2001 Kia Rio. It is intended to help identify potential causes before proceeding with repairs.

### Engine Cranks But Does Not Start

- **Battery:** Check battery terminals for corrosion and tightness. Test battery voltage.
- **Fuel System:** Ensure adequate fuel level. Listen for the fuel pump priming sound when the ignition is turned to the ON position.
- **Ignition System:** Inspect spark plugs, ignition coils, and associated wiring for damage or wear.
- **Immobilizer:** Verify the security light is off, indicating the immobilizer system is not active.

### Engine Overheating

- **Coolant Level:** Check the coolant reservoir and radiator levels (only when the engine is cool).
- **Radiator Fan:** Confirm the cooling fan activates when the engine reaches operating temperature.
- **Leaks:** Inspect radiator, hoses, and water pump for any signs of coolant leakage.
- **Thermostat:** A faulty thermostat can prevent proper coolant flow.

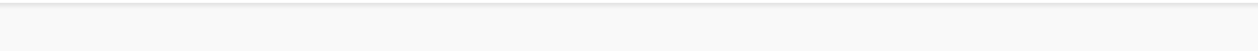
