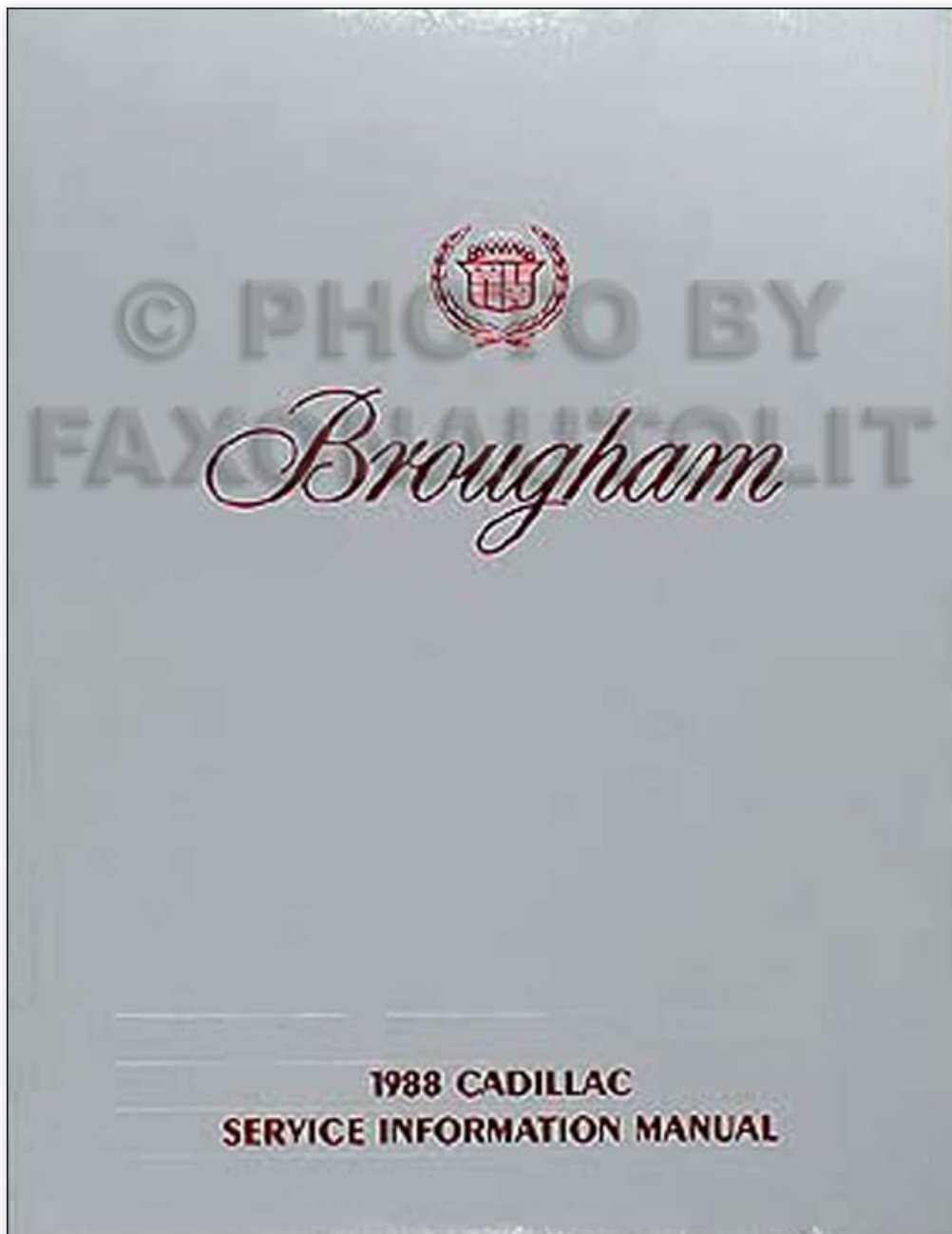


Image 1.1: Front cover of the 1988 Cadillac Brougham Repair Shop Manual. This image displays the official publication, which is the subject of this user guide.
