INTRODUCTION

The CamelBak Lobo 100 oz Hydration Pack is designed for mountain biking and other outdoor activities, providing essential hydration and storage for 3+ hours. This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, maintenance, and care of your hydration pack to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lobo hydration pack integrates a 100 oz (3.05 liters) Antidote reservoir with a lightweight, durable pack designed for active use.

Key Features:

- **Air Director Back Panel:** Provides ventilation to keep your back cool and comfortable.
- **Antidote Reservoir with Quicklink System:** Facilitates easy filling, cleaning, and quick connection/disconnection of the drinking tube.
- **Gel Pocket on Shoulder Harness:** Offers convenient access to energy gels or small items.
- **Slider Sternum Strap and Removable Waist Belt:** Allows for a secure and customizable fit, minimizing pack movement during activity.
- **Organizer Pocket:** Dedicated storage for bike essentials such as tools, spare tubes, and personal items.

- **External Fill Reservoir Access:** Simplifies refilling the reservoir without removing it from the pack.

SETUP

1. Filling the Antidote Reservoir

1. Locate the external fill access flap on the top of the pack.
2. Open the flap to expose the reservoir's fill port.
3. Unscrew the reservoir cap by turning it counter-clockwise.
4. Fill the reservoir with water or your preferred hydration liquid. Do not overfill.
5. Screw the cap back on tightly, ensuring a leak-proof seal.

2. Inserting and Securing the Reservoir

1. Ensure the reservoir is properly seated in its dedicated compartment. The lip of the reservoir should fit over the internal slot.
2. Secure the reservoir with the internal tab and Velcro closure, if present, to prevent it from sliding down.
3. Route the drinking tube through the designated port on either shoulder strap.
4. Attach the bite valve to the magnetic tube trap or clip on the shoulder strap for easy access.

3. Adjusting the Pack

1. Put on the pack and adjust the shoulder straps for a snug, comfortable fit.
2. Fasten the sternum strap across your chest and adjust its height and tension.
3. If using the removable waist belt, fasten it around your waist and tighten for added stability, especially during high-intensity activities.

OPERATING

Drinking from the Bite Valve

- To drink, gently bite down on the silicone bite valve and suck.
- After drinking, release the bite valve to seal it and prevent drips.
- The bite valve features an on/off lever. Turn it to the "off" position when not in use to prevent accidental leaks during transport.

Using Storage Pockets

- Utilize the main organizer pocket for tools, spare parts, and other cycling essentials.
- The gel pocket on the shoulder harness is ideal for quick access to small items like energy gels, lip balm, or keys.
- Distribute weight evenly within the pack for comfort and stability.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Antidote Reservoir

Regular cleaning of your reservoir is crucial to prevent mold and bacteria growth.

1. After each use, empty the reservoir completely.
2. Disconnect the Quicklink drinking tube from the reservoir.

3. Wash the reservoir with warm water and mild soap. Use a CamelBak cleaning brush kit (sold separately) for thorough cleaning of the reservoir interior and drinking tube.
4. For deep cleaning or to remove stubborn odors/tastes, use CamelBak Cleaning Tabs or a mixture of 1/4 bleach and 3/4 water. Let it sit for 30 minutes, then rinse thoroughly.
5. Ensure all soap residue is rinsed out.
6. Hang the reservoir upside down with the opening facing down, or use a CamelBak reservoir dryer (sold separately) to allow it to air dry completely before storage.

Cleaning the Pack

The pack itself should be cleaned periodically.

- Remove the reservoir and all contents from the pack.
- Wipe the pack with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris. For deeper cleaning, hand wash with warm water and mild soap.
- Do not machine wash or tumble dry, as this can damage the fabric and coatings.
- Air dry the pack completely in a well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Low Water Flow:

- Ensure the bite valve's on/off lever is in the "on" position.
- Check if the drinking tube is kinked or pinched.
- Verify the reservoir is not empty.
- Inspect the bite valve and tube for blockages or debris. Clean if necessary.

Leaking:

- Ensure the reservoir cap is screwed on tightly and correctly aligned.
- Check the Quicklink connection between the reservoir and the tube for a secure fit.
- Verify the bite valve's on/off lever is in the "off" position when not in use.
- Inspect the reservoir and tube for punctures or damage.

Unpleasant Taste/Odor:

- Thoroughly clean the reservoir and tube using warm water, mild soap, and a cleaning brush.
- Use CamelBak Cleaning Tabs or a diluted bleach solution (1/4 bleach to 3/4 water) for a deep clean, followed by extensive rinsing.
- Ensure the reservoir is completely dry before storage to prevent mold.
