1. INTRODUCTION

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your combination chamber, consider the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Combination not working.	Incorrect combination entered. Combination changed and forgotten. Internal mechanism obstruction.	Ensure the correct combination is being entered precisely. If recently changed, try previous combination or consult original lock manual for reset procedure. Inspect for debris or damage; clean if necessary.
Buttons feel stiff or sticky.	Accumulation of dirt or debris. Lack of lubrication.	Clean the button area. Apply a small amount of dry graphite lubricant if recommended by the manufacturer.
Lock does not engage/disengage properly.	Misalignment of components. Worn parts.	Recheck installation steps for proper alignment. If parts are worn, replacement may be necessary. Contact support.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, contact Dormakaba customer support or a qualified locksmith.
