Key is stuck or difficult to press.	Debris lodged around the key, or minor misalignment.	Carefully inspect for foreign objects. If none are visible, avoid forcing the key and contact customer support.
Piano wobbles on a flat surface.	Uneven surface or slight manufacturing variation.	Ensure the piano is on a completely flat surface. If wobbling persists, a small felt pad can be placed under the shorter leg.
