INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Electrolux LUX 9000 Guardian HEPA Filter, model F907. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of the filter.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to correctly install the HEPA filter into your compatible Electrolux vacuum cleaner.

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your vacuum cleaner is unplugged from the power outlet before beginning installation.
2. **Locate Filter Compartment:** Refer to your vacuum cleaner's specific user manual to identify the HEPA filter compartment. This is typically located near the exhaust or motor housing.
3. **Remove Old Filter:** Carefully open the filter compartment and remove the old filter. Dispose of the old filter according to local regulations.
4. **Insert New Filter:** Place the new Electrolux LUX 9000 Guardian HEPA Filter (Model F907) into the compartment. Ensure it is seated firmly and correctly oriented. The filter is designed to fit snugly.
5. **Close Compartment:** Securely close the filter compartment door or cover. Ensure it latches properly to maintain an airtight seal.
6. **Power On:** Plug your vacuum cleaner back into the power outlet.

Note: The color of the filter may vary (e.g., grey or blue) but this does not affect its function or compatibility.

OPERATION

Once installed, the HEPA filter operates automatically as part of your vacuum cleaner's filtration system. It is designed to capture microscopic particles, including allergens and fine dust, from the air exhausted by the vacuum.

- The filter works continuously during vacuum operation.
- No specific user interaction is required for the filter's operation after installation.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your HEPA filter is crucial for maintaining optimal air filtration and vacuum performance.

Filter Replacement Schedule

- It is recommended to replace the HEPA filter every 6 to 12 months, depending on usage frequency and household environment (e.g., presence of pets, allergies).
- Signs that a filter replacement may be needed include decreased suction power, noticeable odors from the vacuum exhaust, or visible dirt and discoloration on the filter surface.

Replacement Procedure

Follow the same steps as outlined in the [Setup and Installation](#) section to replace an old filter with a new one.

Cleaning

HEPA filters are generally not designed to be washed or cleaned. Attempting to wash the filter can damage the filtration media and reduce its effectiveness. Always replace a dirty HEPA filter with a new one.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues related to your vacuum's filtration, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Suction Power	Clogged or old HEPA filter.	Replace the HEPA filter. Check other filters and dust bag/canister.
Unpleasant Odor from Exhaust	Saturated or dirty HEPA filter.	Replace the HEPA filter.
Filter Does Not Fit	Incorrect filter model.	Verify that you have the correct filter (Model F907) for your Electrolux LUX 9000 Guardian vacuum.
