Setup

Operating Instructions

- **Soil Cultivation:** For loosening compacted topsoil, hold the hoe at an angle and chop or pull the blade through the soil. This helps aerate the soil and prepare it for planting.
- **Creating Furrows:** To create small trenches for planting seeds or seedlings, drag the corner of the

hoe blade along the desired line in the soil. The 48-inch handle provides good leverage for consistent depth.

- **Safety:** Maintain a firm grip on the handle. Be aware of your surroundings and avoid striking hard objects or underground utilities. Keep children and pets away from the work area.

Maintenance

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Truper Garden Hoe and ensure its continued effectiveness.

1. **Cleaning:** After each use, remove all soil and debris from the hoe head and handle. A stiff brush or cloth can be used.
2. **Drying:** Ensure the metal head is thoroughly dried to prevent rust.
3. **Rust Prevention:** Periodically apply a light coat of oil (e.g., linseed oil or general-purpose machine oil) to the metal head to protect it from rust, especially before long-term storage.
4. **Handle Care:** The wood handle can be wiped clean. If the wood appears dry, a light application of linseed oil can help preserve it.
5. **Storage:** Store the hoe in a dry, covered area, away from direct sunlight and moisture. Hang the tool if possible to prevent damage to the blade or handle.

Troubleshooting

The Truper Green Built Welded Garden Hoe is a simple, durable tool with minimal components. Most issues are related to normal wear and tear or improper use.

- **Loose Head:** If the hoe head becomes loose, inspect the weld. If the weld is compromised, the tool may need replacement. Do not attempt to repair a broken weld yourself as it can compromise safety.
- **Dull Blade:** While not designed for razor sharpness, the blade can be maintained with a file or sharpening stone if it becomes too dull for effective cutting. Always sharpen away from your body and wear protective gloves.
- **Handle Damage:** Cracks or splinters in the wood handle can be sanded smooth. Severe damage to the handle may necessitate replacement of the tool for safety.
