# Quantum J-32U Portable CD/MP3 Player, USB, Radio, and Cassette Recorder User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Quantum J-32U Portable CD/MP3 Player, USB, Radio, and Cassette Recorder. This device is designed to provide versatile audio playback and recording capabilities in a compact, portable unit. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the unit to ensure proper use and to maximize its performance.

Keep this manual for future reference.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Power Source:** Operate the unit only from the power source indicated on the marking label.
- **Ventilation:** Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- **Water and Moisture:** Do not use this apparatus near water or moisture.
- **Cleaning:** Clean only with a dry cloth.
- **Heat:** Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- **Servicing:** Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the apparatus has been damaged in any way.
- **Batteries:** Dispose of used batteries according to local regulations. Do not expose batteries to excessive heat.

## 4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

### 4.1 Front Panel

1. **Speakers:** Stereo speakers for audio output.
2. **LCD Display:** Shows current mode, track number, and radio frequency.
3. **Function Buttons:** Play/Pause, Stop, Skip/Search (Forward/Backward).
4. **Volume Control:** Rotary knob to adjust audio output level.
5. **Mode Button:** Selects between CD, USB/SD, Radio, and Cassette modes.

### 4.2 Top Panel

1. **CD Compartment:** Top-loading CD/MP3 disc tray.
2. **Cassette Deck:** For playing and recording cassette tapes.
3. **USB Port:** For connecting USB flash drives.
4. **SD/MMC Card Slot:** For inserting SD or MMC memory cards.
5. **Tuning Knob:** For manual radio frequency selection.
6. **Cassette Control Buttons:** Play, Record, Fast Forward, Rewind, Stop/Eject.

#### **4.3 Rear Panel**

1. **AC Power Input:** Connect the supplied AC power cord here.
2. **Battery Compartment:** For inserting batteries for portable operation.
3. **FM Antenna:** Telescopic antenna for FM radio reception.

## 5. SETUP

### 5.1 Powering the Unit

The J-32U can be powered by AC mains or batteries.

#### AC Power

1. Ensure the unit is turned off.
2. Connect the supplied AC power cord to the AC power input on the rear panel of the unit.
3. Plug the other end of the AC power cord into a standard wall outlet.

#### Battery Power

1. Open the battery compartment cover on the rear panel.
2. Insert the required number of "C" size batteries (not included), ensuring correct polarity (+/-).

3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.
4. *Note:* Disconnect the AC power cord when operating on batteries.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 6.1 General Operation

- **Power On/Off:** Press the **POWER** button to turn the unit on or off.
- **Mode Selection:** Press the **MODE** button repeatedly to cycle through CD, USB/SD, Radio (AM/FM), and Cassette modes.
- **Volume Adjustment:** Rotate the **VOLUME** knob to increase or decrease the sound level.

### 6.2 CD/MP3 Playback

1. Press the **MODE** button to select CD mode.
2. Open the CD compartment cover.
3. Place a CD or MP3 CD with the label side facing up.
4. Close the CD compartment cover. The unit will read the disc.
5. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to start playback.
6. Press **SKIP FORWARD** or **SKIP BACKWARD** to navigate tracks.
7. Press and hold **SKIP FORWARD** or **SKIP BACKWARD** to fast forward or rewind within a track.
8. Press the **STOP** button to stop playback.

### 6.3 USB/SD/MMC Playback

1. Insert a USB flash drive into the USB port or an SD/MMC card into the card slot.
2. Press the **MODE** button to select USB/SD mode. The unit will automatically detect and begin playing MP3 files.
3. Use **PLAY/PAUSE**, **STOP**, **SKIP FORWARD**, and **SKIP BACKWARD** buttons as with CD playback.

### 6.4 Radio Operation (AM/FM Stereo)

1. Press the **MODE** button to select Radio mode.
2. Extend the FM telescopic antenna for better FM reception. For AM, rotate the unit for optimal reception.
3. Rotate the **TUNING** knob to select your desired radio station.
4. The frequency will be displayed on the LCD screen.

### 6.5 Cassette Playback and Recording

#### Playback

1. Press the **MODE** button to select Cassette mode.
2. Press the **STOP/EJECT** button to open the cassette deck.
3. Insert a cassette tape and close the deck.
4. Press the **PLAY** button to start playback.
5. Use **FAST FORWARD** or **REWIND** buttons to navigate the tape.
6. Press **STOP/EJECT** to stop playback.

#### Recording (from CD/USB/SD/Radio)

1. Insert a blank cassette tape into the cassette deck.
2. Select the desired source (CD, USB/SD, or Radio) using the **MODE** button.
3. Start playback on the source (e.g., play a CD track, tune to a radio station).
4. While the source is playing, press the **RECORD** button on the cassette deck. The **PLAY** button will also engage.
5. To stop recording, press the **STOP/EJECT** button.
6. *Note:* Ensure the cassette tape has its record protection tabs intact for recording.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Unit:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **CD Lens Cleaning:** If CD playback becomes erratic, use a commercially available CD lens cleaner disc to clean the laser lens.
- **Cassette Head Cleaning:** Periodically clean the cassette deck's heads, pinch rollers, and capstan with a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, disconnect the AC power cord and remove batteries. Store the unit in a cool, dry place.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	AC cord not connected; Batteries depleted or incorrectly inserted.	Check AC cord connection; Replace batteries or ensure correct polarity.
No sound	Volume too low; Incorrect mode selected.	Increase volume; Press <b>MODE</b> to select correct source.
CD skips or does not play	Disc dirty or scratched; CD compartment not closed; Disc inserted incorrectly.	Clean or replace disc; Close CD compartment firmly; Insert disc label side up.
Poor radio reception	Antenna not extended; Unit position.	Extend FM antenna fully; Rotate unit for better AM reception.
Cassette tape not playing/recording	Tape incorrectly inserted; Record protection tab removed (for recording).	Ensure tape is correctly inserted; Cover record protection tab with tape for recording.
