INTRODUCTION

The NuWave Pro Infrared Oven utilizes patented 3-way cooking technology, combining infrared, convection, and conduction methods to cook food quickly and thoroughly. This innovative approach helps retain moisture and flavor, making it ideal for preparing a wide variety of meals, including fresh or frozen foods in significantly less time than a conventional oven. Its digital keypad offers precise control over cooking times and temperatures, ensuring optimal results.

COMPONENTS AND PARTS

The NuWave Pro Infrared Oven comes as a 7-piece set, designed for versatile cooking. Familiarize yourself with the following components:

- Pro Power Head
- Dome
- 3-inch Extender Ring
- Cooking Rack
- Liner Pan
- Base Tray
- Dome Holder

SETUP

Before first use, ensure all packaging materials are removed and components are clean. Follow these steps to set up your NuWave Oven:

1. Place the Base Tray on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
2. Insert the Liner Pan into the Base Tray.
3. Place the Cooking Rack inside the Liner Pan. The rack is reversible, offering 1-inch or 4-inch height options for different cooking needs.
4. Carefully place the food to be cooked on the Cooking Rack.
5. Position the Dome over the Liner Pan and Cooking Rack, ensuring it sits securely on the Base Tray.
6. Place the Power Head on top of the Dome, aligning it properly. The Power Head is designed to fit snugly.
7. If cooking larger items, such as a 16 lb. turkey, place the 3-inch Extender Ring between the Base Tray and the Dome to increase oven capacity.
8. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The NuWave Oven's digital keypad allows for precise control over your cooking. Here are general steps for operation:

1. Ensure the oven is properly assembled and plugged in.
2. Press the "Cook Time" button on the Power Head.
3. Use the numerical keypad to enter your desired cooking time in minutes.
4. Press the "Start" button to begin the cooking cycle. The oven will immediately begin heating and cooking.
5. Monitor food progress through the transparent dome.
6. For even cooking, especially with thicker items like steaks, you may need to pause the cooking cycle, carefully lift the Power Head and Dome, turn the food, and then replace the Dome and Power Head before resuming cooking.
7. Once cooking is complete, the oven will automatically shut off. Carefully remove the Power Head and Dome using the Dome Holder for safe placement.
8. Use oven mitts to remove the hot Liner Pan and Cooking Rack with your cooked food.

Note: Cooking times may vary based on food type, thickness, and desired doneness. Refer to the included recipe book or online resources for specific cooking guidelines.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your NuWave Oven. Always allow the unit to cool completely before cleaning.

- **Dishwasher Safe Parts:** The Dome, 3-inch Extender Ring, Cooking Rack, and Liner Pan are all dishwasher safe for convenient cleaning.
- **Hand Washing:** For best results and to prolong the life of components, hand washing with warm, soapy water is recommended. Use a non-abrasive sponge or cloth.
- **Power Head:** The Power Head contains electrical components and should NEVER be immersed in water. Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth. Ensure it is completely dry before storage or next use.
- **Base Tray:** Wipe the Base Tray with a damp cloth. Do not immerse in water.
- **Storage:** Store the NuWave Oven in a clean, dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your NuWave Oven, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not turn on.	Not plugged in, power outage, or tripped circuit breaker.	Ensure unit is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check household circuit breaker.
Food not cooking evenly.	Improper food placement, too much food, or not turning food.	Ensure food is centered on the rack. Do not overload. Turn food halfway through cooking.
Dome appears cloudy or stained.	Food residue buildup.	Clean the dome thoroughly after each use. For stubborn stains, soak in warm, soapy water before scrubbing.


