

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ADATA Classic CH94 is a portable external hard drive designed for convenient data storage and transfer. It features a compact 2.5-inch form factor and connects via USB 2.0, offering a reliable solution for backing up files, carrying important documents, or expanding your computer's storage capacity.

3. FEATURES

- **High Capacity:** 750GB storage for various data types.
- **USB 2.0 Interface:** Ensures broad compatibility with computers and devices.

4. SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

To use the ADATA Classic CH94, your system must meet the following requirements:

- Available USB 2.0 or USB 3.0 port (operates at USB 2.0 speeds).
- Operating System: Windows XP/Vista/7/8/10/11, macOS 10.6 or later, Linux Kernel 2.6 or later.

5. SETUP

1. **Connect the Drive:** Plug the integrated USB cable from the ADATA CH94 into an available USB port on your computer.
2. **Automatic Recognition:** Your operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers for the hard drive. This process may take a few moments.
3. **Accessing the Drive:** Once recognized, the drive will appear as a removable storage device in 'My Computer' (Windows) or on the desktop/Finder (macOS). You can now open the drive and begin transferring files.
4. **Formatting (Optional):** The drive comes pre-formatted for general use. If you need to reformat the drive for a specific file system (e.g., NTFS for Windows, HFS+ for macOS), use your operating system's disk management tools. **Warning: Formatting will erase all data on the drive.**

6. OPERATING

- **Transferring Files:** Drag and drop files or folders to and from the ADATA CH94 drive icon. You can also use copy and paste functions.
- **Safe Removal:** Always safely eject the hard drive before disconnecting it from your computer to prevent data corruption.
 - **Windows:** Click the 'Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media' icon in the system tray, then select the ADATA CH94.
 - **macOS:** Drag the drive icon to the Trash, or click the Eject button next to the drive name in Finder.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Physical Care:** Keep the drive in a clean, dry environment. Avoid extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, and strong magnetic fields. Do not drop or subject the drive to physical shock.
- **Data Backup:** Regularly back up important data stored on the external hard drive to another location to prevent data loss in case of drive failure or accidental deletion.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the drive. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Drive Not Detected:**
 - Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the drive and the computer.
 - Try connecting to a different USB port on your computer.
 - Test the drive on another computer to rule out a computer-specific issue.
 - Check Disk Management (Windows) or Disk Utility (macOS) to see if the drive is listed but uninitialized or unformatted.

- **Slow Transfer Speeds:**

- Ensure you are using a direct USB port on your computer, not a USB hub.
- Close other applications that might be using system resources or performing background transfers.
- Defragment the drive (Windows only, not recommended for SSDs).

- **Error Messages During Transfer:**

- Ensure there is sufficient free space on the destination drive.
- Check for file system limitations (e.g., FAT32 has a 4GB file size limit).
- Run a disk check utility on the drive.
