1. INTRODUCTION

The Tristar RA-2949 Raclette Grill is a compact and lightweight appliance designed for preparing raclette and grilling various foods. This manual provides essential information for safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain for future reference.

Important Safety Instructions

- Always ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or oven mitts.
- Unplug the appliance from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Compact Design:** Lightweight and space-saving, ideal for small gatherings or camping.
- **500W Power:** Efficient heating for grilling and melting cheese.
- **4 Raclette Pans:** Suitable for up to four people.
- **Non-Stick Grill Plate:** Removable grill plate with a cooking surface of 22 x 17.5 cm, ensuring easy food release and cleaning.
- **Integrated On/Off Switch:** Simple operation with an indicator light.
- **Cool-Touch Handles:** For safe handling of the raclette pans.
- **Non-Slip Feet:** Provides stability during use.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Tristar Raclette Grill:

1. Carefully remove all packaging materials from the appliance.
2. Place the raclette grill on a flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit.
3. Wash the grill plate and raclette pans with warm soapy water, rinse thoroughly, and dry completely before first use.
4. Place the clean grill plate securely on top of the heating element.
5. Insert the raclette pans into their designated slots under the grill plate.
6. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your raclette grill is simple:

1. Prepare your ingredients: slice cheese, vegetables, meats, etc., into small pieces suitable for the pans and grill plate.
2. Ensure the grill plate and pans are in place.
3. Plug the appliance into a suitable power outlet.
4. Turn the appliance ON using the integrated switch. The indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the grill is heating up.
5. Allow the grill to preheat for approximately 5-10 minutes.
6. Place food directly onto the non-stick grill plate for grilling.
7. Place cheese and other ingredients into the individual raclette pans and slide them under the heating element to melt.
8. Use the cool-touch handles to remove the pans once the cheese is melted or food is cooked to your preference.
9. After use, turn the appliance OFF using the switch and unplug it from the power outlet.
10. Allow the appliance to cool down completely before cleaning.

6. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Proper cleaning ensures the longevity and performance of your raclette grill:

1. Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.
2. Remove the grill plate and raclette pans.
3. Wash the grill plate and raclette pans with warm soapy water using a soft sponge. Do not use abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads, as this can damage the non-stick coating.
4. For stubborn food residues, soak the plate and pans in warm soapy water for a few minutes before cleaning.
5. Wipe the main unit with a damp cloth. Never immerse the main unit in water.
6. Dry all parts thoroughly before reassembling or storing.
7. Store the appliance in a dry place.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Tristar Raclette Grill, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet fault; switch off.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the ON/OFF switch position. Test the outlet with another appliance.
Food is not cooking or melting properly.	Insufficient preheating time; too much food; power issue.	Allow sufficient preheating time (5-10 minutes). Do not overload the grill plate or pans. Ensure the appliance is receiving power.
Smoke or unusual odor during first use.	Residual manufacturing oils.	This is normal for the first use. Ensure good ventilation. If smoke persists, unplug and contact support.
