1. Introduction

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

4. FEATURES

- **Unlock mode:** Option to keep the lock in "unlock mode" when you need more frequent access to your cabinets.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Safety 1st Magnetic Locking System is designed for easy installation inside most cabinets and drawers. Follow these steps for proper setup:

1. Prepare the Surface: Ensure the inside surfaces of your cabinet or drawer and the cabinet door/drawer

front are clean and dry.

- 2. **Determine Placement:** Identify the optimal location for the lock and latch. The lock should be positioned so that the latch mechanism aligns with the cabinet frame when the door is closed. Ensure there is enough clearance for the latch to engage and disengage.
- 3. **Use the Installation Cradle (if included):** Some kits include an installation cradle or template to assist with precise placement. If available, follow its instructions to mark screw holes accurately.
- 4. **Pre-drill Pilot Holes:** Using a small drill bit (e.g., 1/16 inch), carefully pre-drill pilot holes for the screws. This prevents wood splitting and ensures a secure fit. Do not drill too deep to avoid going through the cabinet material.
- 5. **Mount the Lock:** Secure the main lock unit to the inside of the cabinet door or drawer front using the provided screws. Ensure it is aligned correctly.
- 6. **Mount the Latch:** Secure the latch mechanism to the cabinet frame or drawer interior, aligning it with the lock unit. Test the alignment by gently closing the door/drawer to ensure the lock and latch engage properly. Adjust as needed before fully tightening screws.
- 7. Final Tightening: Once satisfied with the alignment, securely tighten all screws.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your Safety 1st Magnetic Locking System is simple and intuitive:

- 1. **Locking:** When the cabinet or drawer is closed, the magnetic lock automatically engages, preventing it from being opened by children.
- Unlocking with Magnetic Key: To open a locked cabinet or drawer, place the magnetic key on the
 outside surface of the cabinet/drawer, directly over the installed lock. The magnet will disengage the
 lock, allowing you to open the door/drawer. Remove the key once opened.
- 3. **Unlock Mode:** For periods when childproofing is not needed (e.g., when children are not present, or for frequent access), you can set the lock to "unlock mode." This typically involves a small switch on the lock unit that keeps the latch disengaged. Refer to the specific lock unit for the exact mechanism.
