1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new Casio High Speed Exilim EX-ZR100 Digital Camera. This camera is designed to capture high-quality photos and Full HD videos with exceptional speed and versatility. Featuring a 12.1-megapixel CMOS sensor and a powerful 12.5x optical zoom lens, it is ideal for capturing everything from wide landscapes to distant subjects. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, and maintenance of your camera to ensure you get the most out of its advanced features.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

4. CAMERA OVERVIEW

4.1 Front View

5. SETUP

5.1 Inserting Battery and Memory Card

1. Open the battery/card compartment cover located on the bottom of the camera.
2. Insert the Lithium-Ion battery (NP-6L) into the battery slot, ensuring correct orientation.
3. Insert a compatible SD memory card into the card slot until it clicks into place.
4. Close the compartment cover securely.

5.2 Charging the Battery

Connect the camera to a USB power source using the provided USB cable. The charging indicator will illuminate. Charging is complete when the indicator turns off. A full charge typically takes several hours.

5.3 Initial Settings

Upon first power-on, you will be prompted to set the date, time, and language. Follow the on-screen instructions to configure these basic settings.

6. OPERATING THE CAMERA

6.1 Turning On/Off

Press the **ON/OFF** button located on the top of the camera to power it on or off.

6.2 Taking Photos

1. Turn on the camera.
2. Frame your shot using the LCD screen.
3. Press the shutter button halfway down to focus. The focus frame will turn green when focus is achieved.
4. Press the shutter button fully down to capture the image.

6.3 Recording Videos

Press the dedicated **Movie Mode** button to start and stop Full HD (1080p) video recording. The camera supports MP4 video capture format.

6.4 Zooming

Use the zoom lever around the shutter button to adjust the 12.5x optical zoom. The camera also features a 2x digital zoom for extended reach.

6.5 Reviewing Images/Videos

Press the **Playback** button to enter playback mode. Use the directional buttons to navigate through your captured photos and videos.

7. ADVANCED FEATURES

- **High-Speed Continuous Shooting:** Capture fast-moving action with up to 10 frames per second.
- **High-Speed Video (Slow Motion):** Record video at high frame rates for smooth slow-motion playback.
- **HDR (High Dynamic Range):** Combine multiple exposures to create images with enhanced detail in both highlights and shadows.
- **Panorama:** Easily create wide panoramic images by sweeping the camera across a scene.
- **Shooting Modes:** Select from various modes including Automatic, Easy, Shutter Priority, Aperture Priority, Manual, and Program to suit different shooting conditions and creative preferences.
- **Wi-Fi Connectivity:** Transfer images and videos wirelessly to compatible devices.

8. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Camera:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera body. For the lens and LCD screen, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution.
- **Battery Care:** Store the battery in a cool, dry place when not in use. Avoid fully discharging the battery regularly to prolong its lifespan.

- **Storage:** When storing the camera for extended periods, remove the battery and memory card. Store the camera in a dry, dust-free environment.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Camera does not turn on:** Ensure the battery is fully charged and correctly inserted.
- **Images are blurry:** Check that the lens is clean. Ensure the camera is properly focused before taking a shot. Use image stabilization if available.
- **Memory card error:** Ensure the memory card is correctly inserted and not full. Try formatting the card (this will erase all data).
- **Flash not firing:** Check flash settings to ensure it is set to Auto or On.
