# SETUP

- 1. **Add Coffee Grounds:** Measure the appropriate amount of ground coffee for your desired brew volume and add it evenly into the inserted basket filter. Do not overfill the filter, as this can lead to overflow or improper extraction.
- 2. **Position Filter Holder:** Carefully place the filter holder, with the coffee and filter, back into the coffee machine according to the machine's specific instructions.
- 3. **Initiate Brewing:** Follow your coffee machine's operating instructions to start the brewing cycle. The filter will effectively separate the coffee grounds from the brewed coffee.
- 4. **Dispose After Use:** Once brewing is complete and the coffee has been dispensed, carefully remove the filter holder. Dispose of the used coffee grounds and filter responsibly. These filters are single-use and biodegradable.

# **M**AINTENANCE

These coffee filters are disposable and require minimal maintenance. Proper storage is key to maintaining their integrity.

- **Storage:** Store unused filters in their original packaging in a dry, cool environment, away from direct sunlight and strong odors. Humidity can affect the paper's structure and filtration performance.
- **Disposal:** Used filters and coffee grounds should be disposed of in general waste or composted where facilities allow.

# **Troubleshooting**

While these filters are straightforward to use, here are solutions to common issues:

#### • Coffee Grounds in Brewed Coffee:

- Ensure the filter is correctly seated in the filter holder without any folds or gaps.
- Verify that the filter size (152/437mm) is appropriate for your specific coffee machine model.

#### • Slow Filtration or Overflow:

- Check if the coffee grounds are too fine, which can clog the filter.
- Ensure the filter is not overfilled with coffee grounds.

#### · Unusual Taste in Coffee:

- Confirm that you are using a fresh, unused filter.
- Ensure the coffee machine's filter holder and brewing components are clean.
