BRIO Metro Railway Set - Model 33513 Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides comprehensive guidance for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your BRIO Metro Railway Set, Model 33513. This 20-piece set is designed for children aged 3 years and up, offering an interactive play experience with a metro train, station, and various accessories. The set is crafted from FSC-certified wood and other durable materials, ensuring product quality and environmental responsibility. It is fully compatible with all BRIO wooden train track sets, allowing for expanded play scenarios.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your Metro Railway Set:

1. **Track Assembly:** Connect the wooden track sections to form a complete railway loop. The set includes 8 curved sections, 1 switch track, and 1 buffer. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. **Battery Installation (Train Engine):** The train engine requires 2 LR44 batteries for its light and sound functions. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the engine. Use a small screwdriver to open the compartment, insert the batteries with correct polarity (+/-), and secure the cover.
3. **Positioning the Metro Station and Tunnel:** Place the metro station and tunnel sections onto the assembled track. The station should be positioned to allow the train to stop inside, and the tunnel can be placed anywhere along the track.
4. **Placing Accessories:** Position the ticket kiosk and metro map board near the station. Place the passenger figurines and suitcase as desired to enhance the play environment.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Train Operation

The metro train engine is push-powered. Push the train along the tracks to activate its lights and sound features. The faster the train is pushed, the more pronounced the light and sound effects will be.

4.2 Station and Car Features

- **Sliding Doors:** The passenger cars and the metro station feature sliding doors. These can be manually opened and closed to simulate passenger boarding and alighting.
- **Ticket Kiosk and Metro Map:** Use the ticket kiosk and metro map board to enhance realistic play scenarios, allowing figurines to 'purchase tickets' and 'plan their route'.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

To clean the wooden and plastic components of the set, wipe them with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the finish or materials. Ensure all parts are dry before storage.

5.2 Battery Replacement

If the train's lights or sounds become dim or stop working, it is time to replace the LR44 batteries. Refer to Section 3.2 for battery installation instructions. Always dispose of used batteries responsibly.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions:

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
-------	----------------	----------

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Train lights/sound not working	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries	Check battery polarity or replace with new LR44 batteries.
Tracks not connecting securely	Misalignment of track pieces	Ensure track connectors are fully engaged and aligned.
Sliding doors on cars/station are stiff	Obstruction or dirt in the sliding mechanism	Inspect for any foreign objects and gently clean the tracks of the sliding doors.



