OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Select a Flag:** Gently pull a single flag from the dispenser. The pop-up design ensures the next flag is ready for use.

2. **Apply the Flag:** Position the adhesive end of the flag onto the desired page or document. Ensure the flag extends slightly beyond the edge of the page for easy visibility.
3. **Marking and Tabbing:** Use the flags to mark specific pages, highlight important lines, or create color-coded sections for quick reference.
4. **Repositioning:** If you need to move a flag, gently peel it off the surface. The adhesive is designed to allow for clean removal and reapplication without damaging paper.




Figure 4: Post-it flags marking sections in an open notebook. The image highlights how the flags are ideal for marking documents without writing on them, showing various colored flags (pink, blue, yellow) used to tab different sections of handwritten notes.

MAINTENANCE

To maintain the adhesive quality and appearance of your Post-it flags, store them in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keep them in their original dispenser to prevent dust and debris from accumulating on the adhesive surface.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Flags not sticking well:

- Ensure the surface is clean and dry before application. Dust, oils, or moisture can reduce adhesive effectiveness.
- Avoid touching the adhesive side of the flag with your fingers, as natural oils can degrade the stickiness.
- If flags have been stored in extreme conditions (very hot or cold), allow them to return to room temperature before use.

Flags tearing paper upon removal:

- While designed for clean removal, very delicate or aged paper might be susceptible to tearing. Exercise caution when removing flags from such surfaces.
- Peel the flag slowly and at a low angle (close to the surface) to minimize stress on the paper.
