# Sony RDPM5IP 30-Pin iPhone/iPod Portable Speaker Dock Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

The Sony RDP-M5iP speaker dock is designed to enhance your music experience on the go. This portable speaker dock offers rich sound reproduction and convenient features for your 30-pin iPhone or iPod devices.

### Key Features:

- Up to 10 hours of continuous AAA battery operation for portable use.
- Easy-access battery compartment for quick battery swaps.
- Charges your iPod or iPhone while docked, preventing battery drain.
- Stereo speakers deliver full, rich bass tones for an enjoyable listening experience.

## SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Sony RDPM5IP speaker dock:

1. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided AC power adapter to the DC IN jack on the speaker dock and then to a wall outlet. Alternatively, for portable use, insert 4 AAA batteries into the battery compartment.
2. **Device Docking:** Carefully align your 30-pin iPhone or iPod with the dock connector on the speaker and gently push down until it is securely seated.
3. **Power On:** Press the power button on the speaker dock or the remote control to turn on the device.
4. **Volume Adjustment:** Use the volume controls on the speaker dock or remote control to set your desired listening level.

### Enhancing Connectivity:

For wireless streaming from newer devices, a 30-pin Bluetooth adapter can be used. For charging older iPods with modern USB-C chargers, a USB-C to 30-pin cable is available.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your device is docked and the speaker is powered on, you can control your music playback:

- **Music Playback:** Music from your docked iPhone or iPod will automatically play through the speaker.
- **Volume Control:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the speaker or remote to adjust the volume.
- **Track Navigation:** Use the 'Previous' and 'Next' track buttons on the remote control to skip songs.
- **Play/Pause:** Use the 'Play/Pause' button on the remote control to control playback.
- **Remote Control:** The included remote allows convenient control of playback functions from a distance.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your speaker dock:

- **Battery Replacement:** When operating on batteries, replace all 4 AAA batteries when the power indicator shows low battery. Ensure correct polarity when inserting new batteries.
- **Storage:** Store the speaker dock in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use for extended periods.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Sony RDPM5IP, try the following:

- **No Power:** Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected to both the speaker dock and a working power outlet. If using batteries, check if they are inserted correctly and have sufficient charge.
- **No Sound:** Verify that your iPhone/iPod is properly docked. Check the volume levels on both the speaker dock and your device. Ensure the device is playing music.
- **Remote Control Not Working:** Check the battery in the remote control and replace if necessary. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the speaker dock.
- **Poor Sound Quality:** Ensure your device is securely docked. Try adjusting the volume. If using a Bluetooth adapter, ensure it is properly connected and paired.
