Shure SE215 PRO Wired Earbuds Instruction Manual

1. SETUP

1.1 Unpacking and Included Components

Carefully unpack all items from the packaging. Ensure all components are present:

- Shure SE215 PRO Sound Isolating Earphones
- Detachable 3.5mm Audio Cable
- Protective Carrying Case
- Fit Kit: Various sizes of Foam Sleeves and Flex Sleeves
- 1/4" Adapter

1.2 Choosing the Correct Ear Sleeves

The performance of your SE215 PRO earphones is significantly affected by the fit of the ear sleeves. Experiment with the different sizes and types (foam and flex) provided in the fit kit to find the best seal for your ears. A proper seal ensures optimal sound isolation and bass response.

- **Foam Sleeves:** Offer excellent sound isolation and a secure fit. Compress the foam before inserting into the ear canal.
- **Flex Sleeves:** Provide a comfortable fit and good sound isolation.

1.3 Attaching Earphones to the Cable

The SE215 PRO features a durable, reinforced detachable cable with MMCX connectors. This allows for easy replacement or customization.

1. Identify the left (L) and right (R) earpieces and cable connectors.
2. Align the earpiece connector with the cable connector.
3. Push firmly until you hear a click, indicating a secure connection. The MMCX connector allows 360-degree rotation for a comfortable fit.

1.4 Wearing the Earphones

The SE215 PRO earphones are designed for an over-the-ear fit, which helps keep them securely in place and cables out of the way.

1. Insert the chosen ear sleeve into your ear canal, ensuring a snug seal.
2. Route the cable over the top of your ear and down your back. The wireform section of the cable can be gently molded to fit the contour of your ear for added stability.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Sound Isolation Technology

The SE215 PRO earphones utilize Sound Isolating technology, which blocks up to 37 dB of outside noise. This passive noise reduction allows for a more immersive listening experience without the need for active noise cancellation.

- A proper seal with the ear sleeves is crucial for effective sound isolation.
- This feature is beneficial in noisy environments, such as during travel or exercise.

2.2 Connecting to Audio Devices

Connect the 3.5mm jack of the earphone cable to the audio output port of your smartphone, music player, or other compatible device.

2.3 Volume Control

The SE215 PRO earphones do not feature integrated volume controls. Adjust the audio volume directly from your connected audio source device.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning the Earphones and Sleeves

Regular cleaning helps maintain hygiene and optimal sound quality.

- **Ear Sleeves:** Remove the ear sleeves from the earphones. Clean them with a mild soap and water solution, rinse thoroughly, and allow them to air dry completely before reattaching. Replace sleeves if they become worn or damaged.
- **Earphone Nozzles:** Gently wipe the earphone nozzles with a dry, soft cloth. Use the included cleaning tool to carefully remove any earwax buildup from the nozzle opening. Avoid pushing debris further into the earphone.

3.2 Cable Care

The detachable cable is designed for durability, but proper care extends its lifespan.

- Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the cable.
- When detaching the cable, grasp the connector firmly, not the cable itself.

3.3 Storage

When not in use, store your SE215 PRO earphones in the provided protective carrying case to prevent tangling and damage.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

4.1 No Sound or Low Sound

- Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted into your audio device.
- Check that the earphone cables are securely connected to the earpieces.
- Verify the volume level on your audio source device.
- Confirm that the ear sleeves are properly seated in your ear canal to create a good seal.

4.2 Poor Sound Quality (Lack of Bass, Tinny Sound)

- The most common cause is an improper seal. Re-evaluate your ear sleeve choice and fit. Try

different sizes or types of sleeves.

- Ensure the earphone nozzles are clear of debris.
- Test with a different audio source or cable to rule out device or cable issues.

4.3 Earphones Falling Out

- Ensure you are using the correct size and type of ear sleeves for a secure fit.
- Confirm the cable is routed over your ear and the wireform is shaped to your ear's contour.
