Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient installation and use of your VonHaus TV Wall Mount. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and retain it for future reference. This fixed wall mount is designed for 15-42 inch VESA compatible screens with a maximum load capacity of 40kg.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the wall structure can safely support the combined weight of the mount and the television.
- Do not mount onto plasterboard alone. Appropriate fixings for plasterboard without studs must be purchased separately.
- Always use a stud finder to locate wooden studs or ensure you are drilling into solid brick or concrete.
- Verify VESA compatibility of your TV before installation.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 40kg.
- Keep all small parts and packaging materials away from children.
- If unsure about any part of the installation, consult a qualified professional.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please check that all components are present and undamaged before beginning installation.

- Mounting Hardware Kit (screws, anchors, washers)
- Integrated Spirit Level
- Instruction Manual




Figure 1: Included mounting hardware and the main bracket components. All necessary fixtures and fittings are provided for standard installations.




Figure 3: The ultra-slim profile of the mounted TV, sitting 27mm from the wall.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Before starting, ensure you have the necessary tools: a drill, a Phillips head screwdriver, a hammer, and a pencil. An integrated spirit level is included with the mount for precise installation.

Step 1: Prepare the Wall

- 1. Determine the desired height for your TV.
- 2. Use a stud finder to locate wooden studs if mounting on a stud wall. For concrete or brick walls, ensure the wall is solid.
- 3. Mark the drilling points on the wall using the mount as a template and the integrated spirit level to ensure it is perfectly horizontal.




Figure 4: Wall types suitable for installation (Concrete, Brick, Stud Wall). Do not mount onto plasterboard alone.

Step 2: Drill Holes and Secure Mount

- 1. Drill pilot holes at the marked points. The size of the drill bit will depend on the type of wall and the anchors provided.
- 2. Insert wall anchors (if required for your wall type) into the drilled holes, tapping gently with a hammer if necessary.
- 3. Align the wall mount bracket with the holes and secure it to the wall using the provided screws and a Phillips head screwdriver. Ensure it is firmly attached and level.

Step 3: Attach Brackets to TV

- 1. Carefully place your TV face down on a soft, clean surface.
- 2. Attach the vertical TV brackets to the back of your television using the appropriate VESA screws and washers from the hardware kit. Ensure they are securely tightened.

Step 4: Mount TV to Wall Bracket

- 1. With assistance, carefully lift the TV and hook the attached TV brackets onto the wall mount bracket.
- 2. Ensure the TV is securely seated on the wall mount. The design allows for easy and secure hanging.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The VonHaus TV Wall Mount is a fixed bracket designed to hold your television securely in place. Once installed, no further adjustments are typically required.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mount is not level.	Incorrect marking or drilling.	Remove mount, re-mark and re-drill holes ensuring the spirit level is used accurately.
TV does not fit the mount.	Incorrect VESA size or TV size.	Verify your TV's VESA pattern and size against the specifications (50x50, 75x75, 100x100, 200x200, 300x200 mm for 15-42 inch TVs).
Mount feels unstable.	Screws not fully tightened, incorrect wall anchors, or unsuitable wall type.	Ensure all screws are securely tightened. Confirm wall type is suitable and correct anchors were used. If unsure, consult a professional.
Missing parts.	Packaging error.	Contact VonHaus customer support immediately.
