INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. **Inspect Equipment:** Before connecting, visually inspect the mixer, hoses, and regulators for any damage, debris, or worn seals.
2. **Connect Regulators:** Attach the appropriate gas regulators to the oxygen and fuel gas cylinders. Ensure connections are tight and secure.
3. **Connect Hoses:** Connect the oxygen and fuel gas hoses from the regulators to the corresponding inlets on the Victor 0305-0165 Mixer. Oxygen connections are typically right-hand threaded, and fuel gas connections are left-hand threaded. *Always verify correct gas line connections.*
4. **Connect Torch:** Attach the welding or cutting torch to the outlet of the mixer.
5. **Leak Check:** Open the cylinder valves slowly and adjust regulator pressures to the recommended settings. Apply a leak detection solution to all connections. Bubbles indicate a leak. Tighten connections or replace faulty components if leaks are detected.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Victor 0305-0165 Mixer is designed to combine oxygen and fuel gas in precise proportions for welding, cutting, or heating applications.

1. **Gas Flow Adjustment:** The mixer features adjustable flow controls (interpreting "Adjustable Speed Control" as flow/mixture). Slowly open the oxygen and fuel gas valves on the mixer to achieve the desired flow rates. Refer to your torch manufacturer's recommendations for specific pressure and flow settings for your application.
2. **Mixture Control:** Adjust the gas flow controls to achieve the correct gas mixture for your specific task. An improper mixture can lead to inefficient operation or unsafe conditions.
3. **Ignition:** Once the desired gas mixture is flowing, ignite the torch using a spark lighter. Never use matches or a cigarette lighter.
4. **Shut Down:** To shut down, first close the fuel gas valve on the torch, then the oxygen valve. Next, close the fuel gas cylinder valve, followed by the oxygen cylinder valve. Bleed the lines by opening the torch valves briefly until the pressure gauges read zero. Finally, close the torch valves.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your Victor 0305-0165 Mixer.

- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the mixer for any signs of wear, damage, or corrosion. Pay close attention to valve stems, seals, and connection points.
- **Cleaning:** Keep the mixer clean and free from oil, grease, and dirt. Use a clean, dry cloth. Do not use harsh

chemicals or solvents that could damage seals or components.

- **Leak Checks:** Perform a leak check regularly, especially after any component changes or if the equipment has been stored for an extended period.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the mixer in a clean, dry environment, away from extreme temperatures and corrosive materials. Disconnect from gas cylinders and store hoses properly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gas Leak Detected	Loose connections, damaged O-rings/seals, faulty valve.	Tighten connections. Replace damaged O-rings or seals. If valve is faulty, replace the mixer or have it serviced by a qualified technician.
Incorrect Flame/Mixture	Improper gas flow settings, clogged orifices in torch.	Adjust gas flow controls on the mixer and regulators. Clean torch orifices.
No Gas Flow	Cylinder valves closed, regulators not set, clogged lines.	Open cylinder valves. Adjust regulator pressures. Check hoses for kinks or blockages.
