INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for assembling the Billy Handmade Dollhouse Kit Kyoto Series Kyomachiya Kit II Pickles Shop, model 8503. This highly detailed miniature kit allows you to recreate a traditional Kyoto pickle shop, capturing authentic features down to the smallest detail. The kit includes all necessary parts and materials for construction. Please note that some small parts or fabric patterns may vary slightly from the images shown.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- 2. Cutting:** Precisely cut out cardboard pieces along indicated lines. Use a sharp craft knife for clean edges.
- 3. Folding:** Score fold lines lightly before folding to achieve crisp, accurate bends.
- 4. Gluing:** Apply adhesive sparingly and evenly. Hold pieces in place until the glue sets.
- 5. Detailing:** Attach smaller decorative elements, such as the shop's interior items and exterior signage, as per the instructions.

OPERATING (DISPLAY AND HANDLING)

Once assembled, your Billy Handmade Dollhouse Kit is a delicate display piece. Handle it with care to preserve its intricate details.

- **Display:** Place the finished model on a stable, flat surface away from direct sunlight, excessive heat, or humidity to prevent material degradation.
- **Handling:** When moving the model, support it from the base to avoid stressing delicate components. Avoid touching small, attached details directly.

MAINTENANCE

Regular, gentle maintenance will help keep your miniature pickle shop looking its best.

- **Dusting:** Use a soft, dry brush or a can of compressed air to gently remove dust from surfaces and crevices. Avoid using wet cloths, which can damage cardboard or painted surfaces.
- **Cleaning:** For stubborn spots, a very lightly dampened cotton swab can be used, but test on an inconspicuous area first. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Storage:** If storing the model, place it in a sturdy box with protective padding to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Missing Pieces:** Before starting assembly, carefully check all included parts against the kit's parts list. If pieces are missing, contact the retailer or manufacturer immediately.
- **Assembly Difficulties:** If you encounter difficulty with a specific step, re-read the instructions carefully and examine the diagrams. Sometimes, a small detail or orientation can be overlooked. Do not force parts together.
- **Damaged Parts:** If a part is damaged during assembly, assess if it can be repaired with glue. For irreparable damage, contact the retailer or manufacturer for possible replacement parts.
