Camp Chef Everest 2 Burner Stove

USER MANUAL

1. Product Overview

The Camp Chef Everest 2 Burner Stove is a powerful and portable cooking solution designed for outdoor enthusiasts. Featuring two 20,000 BTU burners, it offers robust heating capabilities for various cooking needs. Its compact design with a folding lid ensures easy transport and storage, making it ideal for camping trips and outdoor excursions. The stove is constructed with durable materials, including a stainless steel drip tray for easy cleaning.

2. Safety Information

Always prioritize safety when operating gas appliances. This stove is designed for outdoor use only in well-ventilated areas. Do not operate indoors or in enclosed spaces. Ensure all connections are secure and leak-free before lighting. Keep flammable materials away from the stove during operation.

Gas Leak Check: Before each use, apply a soapy water solution to all gas connections. Bubbles indicate a leak. Tighten connections or replace parts as necessary. Never use a flame to check for leaks.

3. Package Contents

Verify that all components are present upon unpacking:

- Camp Chef Everest 2 Burner Stove unit
- Propane cylinder adapter (for 1 lb propane cylinders)
- Stainless steel drip tray
- Integrated carry handle

4. Setup

Follow these steps for initial setup:

1. Place the stove on a stable, level, non-combustible surface away from any flammable materials.
2. Open the folding lid. The lid also functions as a three-sided wind screen.
3. Ensure the burner grates are properly seated over the burners and the stainless steel drip tray is in place.
4. Connect the propane cylinder adapter to the stove's gas inlet.
5. Attach a 1 lb propane cylinder to the adapter, ensuring a tight, leak-free connection. Perform a gas leak check as described in the Safety Information section.

5. Operating Instructions

The Everest stove features matchless ignition for convenience.

1. Ensure the propane cylinder is connected and the gas valve on the cylinder is open.
2. Turn the desired burner control knob to the 'HIGH' position.
3. Immediately press the red igniter button located on the front panel. You should hear a click and see the burner ignite. If it does not ignite after a few attempts, turn off the gas, wait 5 minutes, and try again. If still unsuccessful, use a long match or lighter to ignite the burner manually.
4. Once ignited, adjust the flame intensity by rotating the control knob to achieve the desired heat level, from a gentle simmer to a powerful 20,000 BTU output.
5. The folding lid provides a 3-sided wind screen, helping to maintain consistent heat distribution and protect the

flame from wind.

6. After cooking, turn the burner control knobs to the 'OFF' position and close the gas valve on the propane cylinder.

6. Maintenance

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Camp Chef Everest stove.

- **Cleaning:** Allow the stove to cool completely before cleaning. Remove the burner grates and stainless steel drip tray. Wash these components with warm, soapy water. Wipe down the stove body with a damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Storage:** Ensure the stove is clean and dry before storing. Close the lid and secure the latches. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the gas hose and connections for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage. Replace any damaged parts immediately.

7. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your stove, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not ignite	No gas flow, clogged burner, faulty igniter, low propane.	Check propane cylinder connection and level. Clear burner ports. Use manual ignition if igniter fails.
Low flame or inconsistent flame	Low propane, clogged burner, regulator issue.	Replace propane cylinder. Clean burner. Ensure regulator is properly connected.
Gas odor detected	Gas leak.	Immediately turn off gas. Perform soapy water leak test. Do not operate if leak persists. Contact customer support.
