INTRODUCTION

They are suitable for various tasks including cutting, gripping, and twisting.

SETUP

The Manley 2006 Pliers are ready for use directly out of the packaging. No assembly is required.

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the pliers from their packaging.
2. **Initial Inspection:** Before first use, visually inspect the pliers for any manufacturing defects or shipping damage. Ensure the jaws open and close smoothly and the handles provide a firm grip.
3. **Clean (Optional):** If desired, wipe down the pliers with a clean, dry cloth to remove any dust or residue from packaging.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Manley 2006 Pliers are versatile tools. Here are general instructions for their primary functions:

Gripping and Holding:

1. Open the jaws by squeezing the handles together (due to spring-loaded design).
2. Position the object to be gripped between the parallel jaws.
3. Release the handles to allow the spring to close the jaws firmly around the object. The parallel action ensures even pressure distribution.
4. Apply additional hand pressure to secure the grip as needed.

Cutting:

1. Locate the side cutters near the pivot point of the pliers.
2. Position the material to be cut within the cutting edges.
3. Apply firm, steady pressure to the handles to cut through the material.
4. *Note:* These pliers are designed for cutting various materials, including fishing hooks and certain wires. Always ensure the material is within the tool's cutting capacity to avoid damage.

Twisting:

1. Grip the material firmly with the parallel jaws.
2. Rotate the pliers to twist the material as required. The strong grip minimizes slippage.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and performance of your Manley 2006 Pliers:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, especially in damp or corrosive environments (e.g., saltwater), clean the pliers thoroughly. Wipe off any dirt, debris, or moisture.
- **Rust Prevention:** Although the pliers have a rust-resistant Teflon coating, regular application of a light oil (like WD-40 or a silicone spray) to the pivot points and metal surfaces will further prevent rust, especially if stored in humid conditions.
- **Storage:** Store the pliers in a dry environment. Avoid storing them in direct contact with other metal tools that could cause scratches or corrosion.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a small amount of lubricant to the pivot points to ensure smooth operation.
- **Handle Care:** Keep the vinyl grips clean and free of grease or oil to maintain a secure hold.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues with pliers are related to improper use or lack of maintenance. Consider the following if you encounter problems:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Jaws feel stiff or gritty	Accumulation of dirt/debris; lack of lubrication; minor rust.	Clean the pivot points thoroughly. Apply a penetrating lubricant and work the jaws open and closed repeatedly. Wipe off excess.
Reduced cutting performance	Dull cutting edges; attempting to cut material beyond capacity.	Cutting edges cannot typically be sharpened by the user. Avoid cutting hardened materials. If severely dull, consider replacement.
Rust spots appearing	Exposure to moisture/corrosive elements without proper cleaning/oiling.	Clean off rust with a fine abrasive pad (e.g., steel wool) and apply a rust-inhibiting oil immediately. Ensure proper drying and oiling after each use.
