HFT 19" x 29" Folding Platform Truck User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and storage of your HFT 19" x 29" Folding Platform Truck, Model DFD330. Please read this manual thoroughly before initial use to ensure proper handling and to prevent injury or damage to the product.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe the following safety precautions to minimize the risk of injury or damage:

- **Load Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 330 pounds (150 kg). Overloading can cause damage to the truck and lead to instability.
- **Secure Loads:** Always ensure that the load is stable and securely placed on the platform before moving. Unevenly distributed or unsecured loads can shift and cause the truck to tip.

- **Clear Path:** Ensure your path is clear of obstacles, debris, and other hazards before moving the truck.
- **Surface Conditions:** Use the platform truck on flat, stable, and level surfaces. Avoid inclines, declines, or uneven terrain which can cause the truck to become unstable.
- **Handle Grip:** Maintain a firm grip on the handle at all times during operation.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the platform truck during use and storage.
- **Personal Protective Equipment:** Wear appropriate safety footwear when handling heavy loads.

SETUP

The HFT Folding Platform Truck comes largely pre-assembled. Follow these steps to prepare it for use:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the platform truck from its packaging. Inspect for any shipping damage.
2. **Unfold Handle:** Locate the folding mechanism at the base of the handle. Gently pull the handle upwards until it locks securely into the upright position. Ensure the locking pins or mechanism are fully engaged to prevent the handle from collapsing during use.
3. **Check Wheels:** Verify that all four casters are securely attached and rotate freely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To effectively use your platform truck:

1. **Place Load:** Position the item(s) to be transported centrally on the platform. Distribute the weight as evenly as possible to maintain balance.
2. **Secure Load (if necessary):** For tall or unstable items, consider using straps or ropes to secure the load to the handle or platform to prevent shifting during transport.
3. **Push or Pull:** Grasp the handle firmly. Push the platform truck forward or pull it backward, depending on the situation and your comfort. Pushing generally offers better control.
4. **Maneuvering:** Use the swivel casters to steer the truck around corners and obstacles. Apply steady, controlled movements.
5. **Stopping:** Bring the truck to a complete stop before attempting to remove the load.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your platform truck:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the platform and frame with a damp cloth as needed to remove dirt and debris. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the finish or materials.
- **Wheel Inspection:** Periodically check the casters for any signs of wear, damage, or entanglement (e.g., hair, string). Remove any debris that may hinder smooth rotation.
- **Lubrication:** If casters become stiff, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to the axle and swivel points.
- **Hardware Check:** Ensure all bolts and fasteners are tight. Tighten any loose hardware as necessary.

STORAGE

For compact storage:

1. **Clear Platform:** Ensure the platform is clear of any items.
2. **Fold Handle:** Release the handle locking mechanism and gently fold the handle down onto the platform. Ensure it

lies flat for compact storage.

3. **Store:** Store the folded platform truck in a dry, clean area, away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight. Its compact design allows it to be stored in a trunk, closet, or garage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wheels do not roll smoothly.	Debris caught in casters; lack of lubrication; damaged caster.	Remove debris. Apply lubricant to axles. Inspect for damage; replace if necessary.
Handle does not lock in upright position.	Locking mechanism not fully engaged; obstruction.	Ensure handle is pulled up completely until it clicks into place. Check for any obstructions preventing full engagement.
Truck is unstable when loaded.	Overloaded; unevenly distributed load; damaged casters.	Reduce load to within capacity. Redistribute load evenly. Inspect and replace damaged casters.
