1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Americh BR7236T-WH Brisa bathtub. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning installation or use. Retain this manual for future reference.

Important Safety Information: Always follow local plumbing and building codes. Ensure all electrical work (if applicable to any optional systems) is performed by a qualified electrician. Use appropriate personal protective equipment during installation.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Americh BR7236T-WH Brisa is designed for drop-in or undermount installation. Proper preparation of the installation site is crucial for optimal performance and longevity.

2.1 Pre-Installation Checks

- Inspect the tub for any shipping damage. Do not install a damaged tub.
- Verify that the rough-in dimensions of your installation site match the tub's specifications (72 x 36 x 22 inches).
- Ensure the subfloor is level and capable of supporting the weight of the tub filled with water (approximately 76 gallons) plus the user.
- Confirm access for plumbing connections (drain and overflow).

2.2 Installation Steps (Drop-In)

1. **Prepare the Opening:** Create a framed opening in your deck or platform that is slightly larger than the tub's rim dimensions to allow for easy placement and sealing.
2. **Position the Tub:** Carefully lower the tub into the prepared opening. The tub is self-leveled, but verify stability and levelness using a spirit level.
3. **Connect Plumbing:** Attach the drain and overflow assembly according to the manufacturer's instructions for the specific drain kit being used. Ensure all connections are watertight.
4. **Test for Leaks:** Fill the tub with water and allow it to sit for a period to check for any leaks around the drain and overflow connections. Address any leaks immediately.
5. **Secure the Tub:** Apply a bead of silicone sealant around the perimeter of the tub where it meets the deck. This provides a

watertight seal and helps secure the tub in place.

6. **Final Finishing:** Complete any tiling or finishing work around the tub deck.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The BR7236T-WH Brisa is a soaker tub designed for relaxation. It features a textured tub floor for safety and integrated armrests for comfort.

3.1 Filling the Tub

- Ensure the drain is closed.
- Turn on the water supply to your desired temperature.
- Fill the tub to a comfortable level, ensuring not to exceed the overflow capacity. The tub has a capacity of 76 gallons.

3.2 Draining the Tub

- Open the drain mechanism.
- Allow all water to completely drain from the tub.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and proper care will maintain the aesthetic appeal and functionality of your Americh Brisa bathtub.

4.1 Cleaning the Acrylic Surface

- Use only non-abrasive cleaners specifically designed for acrylic surfaces. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive pads, or scouring powders, as these can damage the glossy finish.
- For general cleaning, a soft cloth or sponge with mild soap and water is sufficient.
- Rinse the tub thoroughly after cleaning to remove all soap residue.
- For stubborn stains, consult the cleaner's instructions for acrylic tubs.

4.2 Preventing Damage

- Avoid dropping heavy or sharp objects into the tub, which can chip or scratch the acrylic.
- Do not use bath mats with suction cups, as these can trap dirt and potentially damage the finish over time.
- Ensure proper ventilation in the bathroom to prevent mold and mildew buildup.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bathtub.

5.1 Slow Draining

- **Cause:** Hair or debris buildup in the drain.
- **Solution:** Remove the drain stopper and clear any visible obstructions. Use a plumbing snake or a chemical drain cleaner (ensure it's safe for your plumbing system) if necessary.

5.2 Minor Surface Scratches

- **Cause:** Abrasive cleaning or accidental contact with sharp objects.
- **Solution:** Minor scratches on acrylic can often be buffed out using a fine-grit polishing compound specifically designed for acrylic surfaces. Follow the product manufacturer's instructions carefully.

5.3 Leaks Around Drain/Overflow

- **Cause:** Loose connections or worn seals.
- **Solution:** Tighten all drain and overflow connections. If the leak persists, the gaskets or seals may need to be replaced. Consult a qualified plumber.
