Ansell TouchNTuff 92-600 Disposable Nitrile Glove Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of Ansell TouchNTuff 92-600 Disposable Nitrile Gloves. These gloves are designed to offer enhanced chemical splash protection in various applications. Please read this manual thoroughly before use.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Ansell TouchNTuff 92-600 is a disposable nitrile glove engineered for superior protection against chemical splashes. Key features include:

3. PREPARATION AND INSPECTION

Before each use, perform the following steps:

1. Inspect the glove packaging for any signs of damage or compromise. Do not use if the packaging is open or torn.
2. Remove a single glove from the dispenser.
3. Visually inspect the glove for any tears, punctures, or defects. Discard any damaged gloves immediately.
4. Ensure your hands are clean and dry before donning the gloves.

4. USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for proper donning and doffing of the gloves:

4.1 Donning (Putting On)

1. Hold the glove by the cuff with one hand.
2. Slide your other hand into the glove, ensuring your fingers are fully seated.
3. Adjust the glove for a comfortable and secure fit, ensuring the cuff covers the wrist adequately.

4.2 Doffing (Taking Off)

1. Grasp the outside of one glove near the cuff with your gloved hand.
2. Peel the glove off, turning it inside out, and hold it in your gloved hand.
3. With your ungloved hand, slide your fingers under the cuff of the remaining glove.
4. Peel this glove off, turning it inside out, enclosing the first glove inside.
5. Dispose of the gloves immediately in an appropriate waste receptacle.

Important: Avoid touching your skin with the contaminated outer surface of the gloves during doffing.

5. CARE AND STORAGE

As disposable gloves, the TouchNTuff 92-600 requires minimal care. However, proper storage is crucial for maintaining product integrity:

- Store gloves in their original packaging in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight, heat, and fluorescent lighting.
- Avoid exposure to ozone, oils, greases, and solvents, which can degrade the nitrile material.
- Do not reuse gloves. Dispose of them after a single use or if they become compromised.
- After removing gloves, follow standard hand hygiene practices, including washing hands thoroughly.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

While designed for protection, it is important to be aware of potential issues and safety measures:

- **Glove Tear/Puncture:** If a glove tears or punctures during use, immediately remove and replace it. Avoid contact with the substance you are handling.
- **Skin Irritation:** Discontinue use if skin irritation or allergic reaction occurs. Consult a medical

professional if symptoms persist.

- **Chemical Compatibility:** While offering enhanced chemical splash protection, these gloves may not be suitable for all chemicals or prolonged immersion. Always consult chemical compatibility charts if available for specific substances.
- **Storage Conditions:** Improper storage can reduce glove integrity and shelf life.
