1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Timex Weekender 38mm Unisex Analog Watch (Model T2N651) combines classic field-inspired design with practical features for everyday wear. It features a durable brass case, a clear dial with 24-hour military time, and the signature INDIGLO backlight for visibility in low light conditions. The adjustable nylon slip-thru strap ensures a comfortable fit.

- Field-Inspired Design: Cream dial with full Arabic numerals and 24-hour military time.
- Polished Case: Silver-tone 38 mm brass case with mineral glass crystal.
- Comfort Fit: Adjustable 20 mm nylon slip-thru strap, fits wrists up to 8 inches.
- INDIGLO Backlight: For time visibility in the dark.
- Water-Resistant: Safe to 30 m / 100 ft (withstands splashes or brief immersion, not suitable for swimming or bathing).

2. SETUP

Before using your Timex Weekender watch, follow these steps to activate it and set the correct time.

2.1 Initial Activation

Your watch may arrive with a plastic crown guard to preserve battery life during shipping. Remove this guard before first use.

- 1. Carefully remove the plastic crown guard from under the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch).
- 2. Push the crown fully inward towards the watch case. The second hand will begin to move, indicating the watch is active.

2.2 Setting the Time

- 1. Pull the crown outward to the time-setting position. The second hand will stop.
- 2. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time.
- 3. Once the correct time is set, push the crown fully back into the watch case. The second hand will resume movement.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Using the INDIGLO Backlight

The INDIGLO backlight illuminates the watch dial for easy reading in low-light conditions or darkness.

- To activate the INDIGLO backlight, simply press and hold the crown (the same knob used for setting time).
- Release the crown to turn off the backlight.

3.2 Wearing the Watch

The adjustable slip-thru strap allows for a comfortable and secure fit on various wrist sizes.

To adjust the strap, slide the watch through the loops of the strap until it is centered on your wrist. Then, adjust the buckle for a snug yet comfortable fit. The slip-thru design allows for easy interchangeability with other 20mm straps.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Water Resistance

The Timex Weekender watch is water-resistant to 30 meters (100 feet). This means it is suitable for splashes, rain, or brief immersion in water. It is **not** recommended for swimming, showering, or diving, as prolonged exposure to water pressure or hot water can compromise the seals.

4.2 Strap Care

The nylon strap can be cleaned with mild soap and water. Allow it to air dry completely before reattaching to the watch. For leather straps (if applicable), avoid prolonged exposure to water and direct sunlight to prevent damage and discoloration.

4.3 Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by 1 Lithium Metal battery (included). Battery life can vary, but typically lasts several years. When the watch stops, it indicates the battery needs replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Watch Not Ticking

If your watch is not ticking upon arrival, ensure the plastic crown guard has been removed and the crown is fully pushed in. If it still does not tick, the battery may be depleted and require replacement.

5.2 Loud Ticking Sound

Some users may notice a distinct ticking sound from the watch movement. This is a characteristic of certain quartz movements and is generally considered normal for this model. It does not indicate a defect or malfunction.
