Motorcycle Accent Accessory Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Kuryakyn 7772 Lower Front Frame Cover is designed to enhance the aesthetic appeal of your motorcycle by concealing the lower portion of the bike frame. This chrome-plated accessory effectively hides the kickstand assembly, front engine stabilizer, and the footboard mount, providing a cleaner, more streamlined appearance to an often unsightly area of the motorcycle.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always ensure your motorcycle is stable and secure before performing any installation or maintenance. Use appropriate personal protective equipment, such as gloves and eye protection. If you are unsure about any step of the installation process, consult a qualified motorcycle technician. Do not operate the motorcycle with loose or improperly installed parts.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

- 1 x Lower Front Frame Cover
- 1 x Mount Bracket
- 1 x Hardware Kit (fasteners, washers, etc.)

## 5. SETUP (INSTALLATION)

#### Tools Suggested (Not Included):

- Set of Hex Wrenches
- Combination Wrenches

#### Installation Steps:

1. Ensure the motorcycle is turned off and cool. Place the motorcycle on a stable stand or lift to ensure it is secure during installation.
2. Identify the lower front frame area where the kickstand assembly, front engine stabilizer, and footboard mount are located. This is the area the cover is designed to shroud.
3. Carefully position the Kuryakyn 7772 Lower Front Frame Cover to align with the existing mounting points on your motorcycle's frame.
4. Attach the provided mount bracket to the frame cover and then to the motorcycle frame using the hardware kit. Refer to the specific instructions provided with your hardware kit for proper fastener torque specifications.
5. Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened. Do not overtighten.
6. Visually inspect the installed cover to ensure it is properly seated, stable, and does not interfere with any moving parts or controls of the motorcycle.

To maintain the chrome finish of your Kuryakyn 7772 Lower Front Frame Cover, regularly clean it with a soft cloth and a non-abrasive chrome cleaner. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could scratch or damage the finish. Periodically check the mounting hardware for tightness to ensure the cover remains securely attached.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with the Kuryakyn 7772 Lower Front Frame Cover, consider the following:

- **Loose Fitment:** Ensure all mounting hardware is correctly installed and tightened according to the instructions. Verify that the correct mount bracket is used.
- **Improper Alignment:** Re-check the positioning of the cover and bracket against the motorcycle frame. Slight adjustments may be needed to achieve optimal alignment.
- **Scratches or Damage:** For minor scratches on the chrome, specialized chrome polish may help. For significant damage, replacement of the part may be necessary.
