INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Timex Men's T2N609 Analog Leather Strap Quartz Watch. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and to maximize the lifespan of your timepiece.

SETUP AND INITIAL OPERATION

Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) out to position 2. The second hand may stop.
2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time.
3. Push the crown back into position 1 to start the watch.

Setting the Date

1. Pull the crown out to position 1 (first click).
2. Turn the crown counter-clockwise to adjust the date.
3. Once the correct date is displayed, push the crown back into its original position.
4. *Note:* Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this may interfere with the automatic date change mechanism.

Using INDIGLO Night-Light

Your Timex watch features the INDIGLO night-light for easy readability in low-light conditions. Press and hold the crown (or the designated pusher, if applicable) to activate the entire dial illumination. Release the button to turn off the light.

OPERATING FEATURES

World Time Function (if applicable)

The T2N609 model features a world time function, indicated by the city names around the dial. While specific operation details for this model's world time are not provided, typically, a secondary crown or pusher is used to rotate an inner ring or hand to align with your desired time zone, allowing you to view the time in different cities simultaneously. Refer to the markings on your watch for specific indicators.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Watch

- Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, damp cloth.
- For leather straps, avoid excessive moisture. Clean with a dry, soft cloth.
- Do not use chemical cleaners, as they may damage the watch's finish or strap.

Water Resistance

This watch is rated for water resistance (e.g., "WR 100M" visible on the dial, meaning 100 meters). This rating typically means it is suitable for showering, swimming, and snorkeling, but not for high-impact water sports or diving. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any water exposure.

Battery Replacement

When the watch stops or the second hand begins to jump every few seconds (indicating a low battery), it's time for a battery replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If it is, the battery may need replacement.
- **Time Inaccurate:** Ensure the crown is fully pushed in. Extreme temperature changes or strong magnetic fields can affect accuracy. If issues persist, a service may be required.
- **Condensation Under Crystal:** This indicates moisture ingress. Immediately seek professional service to prevent damage to the movement.

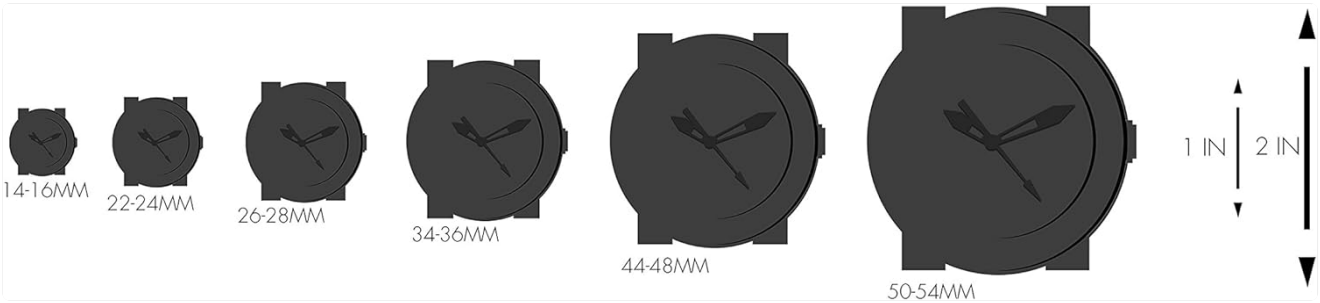
