MAYFLASH Max Shooter Pro for XBOX 360 User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

The MAYFLASH Max Shooter Pro is an adapter designed to connect standard USB mice and keyboards to your XBOX 360 console. This device allows users to experience First Person Shooter (FPS) games and other titles with the precision and control offered by a mouse and keyboard setup. It is fully programmable and includes pre-installed key configurations for popular XBOX 360 games. Advanced features such as Deadzone adjustments and mouse control inversion are available to customize your gaming experience.

2. KEY FEATURES

- Enables connection of USB mice and keyboards to XBOX 360.
- Compatible with all XBOX 360 games and console versions.
- Optimized for First Person Shooter (FPS) games.
- Offers high sensitivity, precision, and smooth control.
- Features 9 programmable levels of mouse speed adjustment.
- Includes 9 degrees of mouse deadzone setup.
- Fully programmable with pre-installed key configurations for popular games.
- Built-in Turbo and Auto Fire functionality.
- Supports firmware and game configuration updates via the official website.
- Plug and play functionality; no wired XBOX 360 controller required for initial setup.
- Compatible with most wired and wireless USB mice and keyboards.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

The Max Shooter Pro package typically includes:

- 1x MAYFLASH Max Shooter Pro Adapter (Model: MAX005)
- 1x User Manual (this document)

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Connect the Max Shooter Pro:** Plug the USB cable of the Max Shooter Pro adapter directly into an available USB port on your XBOX 360 console.
2. **Connect Keyboard and Mouse:** Plug your USB keyboard and USB mouse into the two USB ports on the Max Shooter Pro adapter. Ensure they are securely connected.
3. **Power On:** Turn on your XBOX 360 console. The adapter should be recognized automatically.
4. **Firmware Update (Recommended):** Before first use, it is highly recommended to check for and install the latest firmware.
 - Visit the official MAYFLASH website for the latest firmware and update instructions.
 - Typically, you will need to connect the Max Shooter Pro to a PC while holding down a specific button on the device until it is recognized, then run the update utility.
5. **Compatibility:** While most wired and wireless USB mice and keyboards are compatible, a list of tested

devices may be available on the manufacturer's website. If your device is not listed, it may still work.

5. OPERATION AND CONFIGURATION

The Max Shooter Pro allows extensive customization of mouse and keyboard controls. Configuration is performed directly via the connected keyboard.

5.1 Basic Adjustments

- **Mouse Speed Adjustment:** Press **ALT + [1-9]** to adjust mouse sensitivity. (e.g., ALT+7 for level 7).
- **Mouse Deadzone Setup:** Press **ESC + [1-3]** to set the mouse deadzone. This controls how small movements are registered.
- **Profile Selection:** The device supports 11 memory slots for custom profiles. Press **ALT + F[1-11]** to switch between profiles.
- **XBOX Live Menu:** The XBOX Live menu can be accessed by pressing the central button on the Max Shooter Pro device.

5.2 Creating Custom Profiles (Key Mapping)

To create a custom key mapping profile:

1. **Enter Configuration Mode:** Hold down the **ESC** key on your keyboard.
2. **Map a Control:** While holding **ESC**, first press the *keyboard key that represents the XBOX 360 controller action* you wish to map (e.g., 'W' for Left Stick Forward, 'X' for Left Stick Press, '3' for Right Stick Press, Left Mouse Button for Right Trigger, Right Mouse Button for Left Trigger). Second, press the *actual keyboard key or mouse button* you want to assign to that controller action. Release **ESC**.
3. **Repeat for all desired mappings:** Continue this process for all buttons and movements you wish to remap.
4. **Save Profile:** After completing your mappings, hold down **ESC** and then press one of the function keys **F1-F11** to save your new profile to that slot.
5. **Exit Configuration Mode:** Release **ESC**.

Example: To map 'W' to Left Stick Forward, 'Right Mouse Button' to Left Trigger, 'Left Mouse Button' to Right Trigger, 'Scroll Wheel Click' to Left Stick Press, and 'Q' to Right Stick Press, and save to F9:

1. Press **ALT + F9** to select an empty profile slot.
2. Hold **ESC**, press **W** (*representing Left Stick Forward*), then press **W** (*actual keyboard key*). Release **ESC**.
3. Hold **ESC**, press **Right Mouse Button** (*representing Left Trigger*), then press **Right Mouse Button** (*actual mouse button*). Release **ESC**.
4. Hold **ESC**, press **Left Mouse Button** (*representing Right Trigger*), then press **Left Mouse Button** (*actual mouse button*). Release **ESC**.
5. Hold **ESC**, press **X** (*representing Left Stick Press*), then press **Scroll Wheel Click** (*actual mouse button*). Release **ESC**.
6. Hold **ESC**, press **3** (*representing Right Stick Press*), then press **Q** (*actual keyboard key*). Release **ESC**.
7. Hold **ESC**, then press **F9** to save.

Refer to the detailed manual provided with the product for a complete list of controller control keys and their representations.

5.3 Turbo and Auto Fire

The Max Shooter Pro includes built-in Turbo and Auto Fire functionalities. Specific activation methods for these

features are typically detailed in the full product manual. These functions allow for rapid, automatic button presses, which can be advantageous in certain games.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Input Delay:** Some users may experience a slight input delay. This is often inherent to converter devices. Ensure your firmware is up to date, and experiment with mouse sensitivity and deadzone settings to find an optimal balance.
- **Keyboard/Mouse Not Recognized:**
 - Ensure both the Max Shooter Pro and your peripherals are securely connected to the XBOX 360.
 - Try different USB ports on the XBOX 360.
 - Verify that your keyboard and mouse are compatible. Check the manufacturer's website for a compatibility list.
 - Update the Max Shooter Pro firmware to the latest version.
- **Configuration Issues:** If you are having difficulty setting up custom key mappings, refer to Section 5.2 and the detailed product manual. Ensure you are correctly entering and saving profiles.
- **No 1:1 PC Feeling:** The Max Shooter Pro converts mouse/keyboard inputs to controller signals. While it enhances precision, it may not perfectly replicate the 1:1 feel of PC gaming due to the console's inherent input processing. Adjusting in-game sensitivity and Max Shooter Pro settings can help optimize the experience.
