INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Taurus Velvet 12-Cup Drip Coffee Maker. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain for future reference. The Taurus Velvet coffee maker is designed for brewing up to 12 cups of drip coffee, featuring a glass carafe, a reusable filter, and an automatic shut-off function for convenience and safety.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended household use.
- Scalding may occur if the lid is removed during the brewing cycle.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Taurus Velvet Coffee Maker:

- Water Reservoir: Holds water for brewing. Features a visible level indicator.
- Filter Basket: Houses the reusable filter and coffee grounds.
- Reusable Filter: Eliminates the need for disposable paper filters.
- Glass Carafe: 12-cup capacity for brewed coffee.
- Warming Plate: Keeps brewed coffee hot after the brewing cycle.
- On/Off Switch: Simple control for starting and stopping the brewing process.

SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and promotional labels from your coffee maker.
- 2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the glass carafe and reusable filter in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Wipe the exterior of the coffee maker with a soft, damp cloth.
- 3. First Cycle (without coffee): Fill the water reservoir to the MAX 12-cup line with fresh, cold water. Place the empty reusable filter in the filter basket. Place the empty carafe on the warming plate. Plug the coffee maker into a standard electrical outlet. Press the On/Off switch to start a brewing cycle. Allow the full cycle to complete. Discard the water from the carafe. This process cleans the internal components and removes any manufacturing residues.
- 4. **Placement:** Place the coffee maker on a flat, stable, heat-resistant surface, away from the edge of the counter. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Open the top lid of the coffee maker. Fill the glass carafe with the desired amount of fresh, cold water (refer to the cup markings on the carafe). Pour the water from the carafe into the water reservoir. Do not exceed the MAX 12-cup line.
- 2. **Add Coffee Grounds:** Place the reusable filter into the filter basket. Add the desired amount of ground coffee into the reusable filter. A general guideline is one tablespoon of ground coffee per cup, but adjust to your personal preference.
- 3. Close Lid: Close the top lid securely.
- 4. **Position Carafe:** Place the empty glass carafe onto the warming plate. Ensure it is properly seated to activate the drip-stop mechanism.
- 5. **Start Brewing:** Plug the coffee maker into a standard electrical outlet. Press the On/Off switch. The indicator light will illuminate, signifying that the brewing cycle has begun.
- 6. Serving: The brewing process will automatically stop when all the water has passed through. The

warming plate will keep the coffee hot until the automatic shut-off activates. You can remove the carafe at any time during the brewing cycle to pour a cup, and the drip-stop feature will temporarily halt the coffee flow. Return the carafe to the warming plate within 20 seconds to prevent overflow.

7. **Automatic Shut-Off:** The coffee maker features an automatic shut-off for safety and energy efficiency, turning off after a period of inactivity.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your coffee maker.

- **Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the coffee maker from the electrical outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Carafe and Reusable Filter: Wash the glass carafe and reusable filter in warm, soapy water after each use. They can also be placed on the top rack of a dishwasher. Rinse thoroughly.
- Filter Basket: The filter basket can be removed for cleaning. Wash it in warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly.
- Exterior: Wipe the exterior surfaces of the coffee maker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads. Never immerse the coffee maker in water or other liquids.
- **Descaling:** Mineral deposits from water can build up over time and affect performance. Descale your coffee maker every 2-4 weeks, depending on water hardness.
 - a. Fill the water reservoir with a mixture of white vinegar and water (1:2 ratio).
 - b. Place the empty carafe on the warming plate.
 - Start a brewing cycle. After about 5 minutes, turn off the coffee maker and let it soak for 30 minutes.
 - d. Turn the coffee maker back on and let the cycle complete.
 - e. Discard the vinegar solution. Run 2-3 cycles with fresh, cold water to rinse thoroughly.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee does not brew.	No power; water reservoir empty; carafe not properly placed.	Check power connection; fill water reservoir; ensure carafe is correctly seated.
Coffee is too weak/strong.	Incorrect coffee-to-water ratio; coffee grind too coarse/fine.	Adjust coffee amount; use appropriate grind for drip coffee.
Water/coffee leaks.	Water reservoir overfilled; filter basket overflowing; carafe not seated.	Do not overfill; ensure filter is not clogged; properly seat carafe.
Brewing is slow.	Mineral buildup (needs descaling).	Perform descaling procedure as described in Maintenance.
