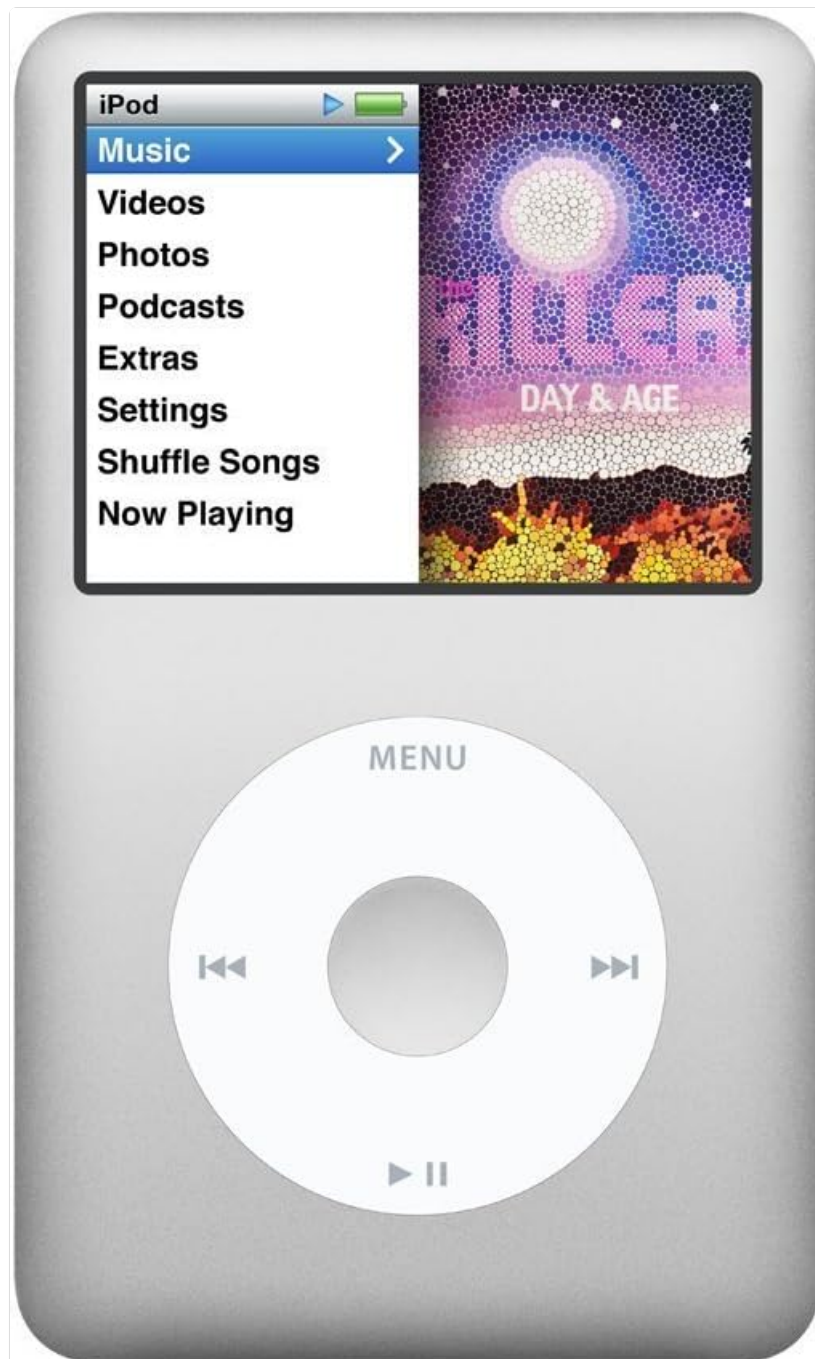
## INTRODUCTION

---

## SETUP

### 1. Charging the iPod Classic

Before first use, fully charge your iPod Classic. Connect the included USB cable to the iPod's dock connector port and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The battery icon on the screen will indicate charging status.

### 2. Installing iTunes

To manage your music, videos, and photos, you need to install Apple iTunes on your computer. Download the latest

version from the official Apple website ([www.apple.com/itunes](http://www.apple.com/itunes)).

### 3. Connecting to Computer

Connect your iPod Classic to your computer using the USB cable. iTunes will automatically launch and detect your device. Follow the on-screen prompts in iTunes to set up your iPod, including naming it and configuring synchronization options.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Navigating the iPod Classic

The iPod Classic is primarily controlled using the Click Wheel. The Click Wheel consists of a touch-sensitive surface and four physical buttons, plus a central button.

- **MENU:** Press to go back to the previous menu or to the main menu.
- **Center Button:** Press to select an item or play/pause.
- **Play/Pause (bottom):** Press to play or pause playback.
- **Previous/Rewind (left):** Press to go to the previous track or hold to rewind.
- **Next/Fast Forward (right):** Press to go to the next track or hold to fast forward.
- **Touch Surface:** Slide your finger clockwise or counter-clockwise around the wheel to scroll through menus and adjust volume.

### Playing Music

1. From the main menu, select **Music**.
2. Navigate through categories such as Artists, Albums, Songs, Genres, etc., using the Click Wheel.
3. Press the Center Button to select a song or album to begin playback.

### Viewing Videos and Photos

- To view videos, select **Videos** from the main menu and choose your desired content.
- To view photos, select **Photos** from the main menu and browse your photo albums.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Cleaning Your iPod Classic

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and casing of your iPod. Avoid using abrasive materials, alcohol, or chemical cleaners, as these can damage the device.

### Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid exposing your iPod to extreme temperatures. For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50% and store it in a cool, dry place.

### Software Updates

Regularly connect your iPod to iTunes to check for and install the latest software updates. This ensures optimal performance and access to new features.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
iPod not responding	Perform a reset: Toggle the Hold switch on and off. Then, press and hold the Center button and the MENU button simultaneously for about 6-10 seconds until the Apple logo appears.
iPod not recognized by computer/iTunes	Ensure iTunes is updated to the latest version. Try a different USB port or cable. Restart your computer and iPod. Check Apple's support website for specific troubleshooting steps for your operating system.
Battery drains quickly	Reduce screen brightness. Avoid extreme temperatures. Ensure the iPod is fully charged before use. If the issue persists, the battery may need service.
