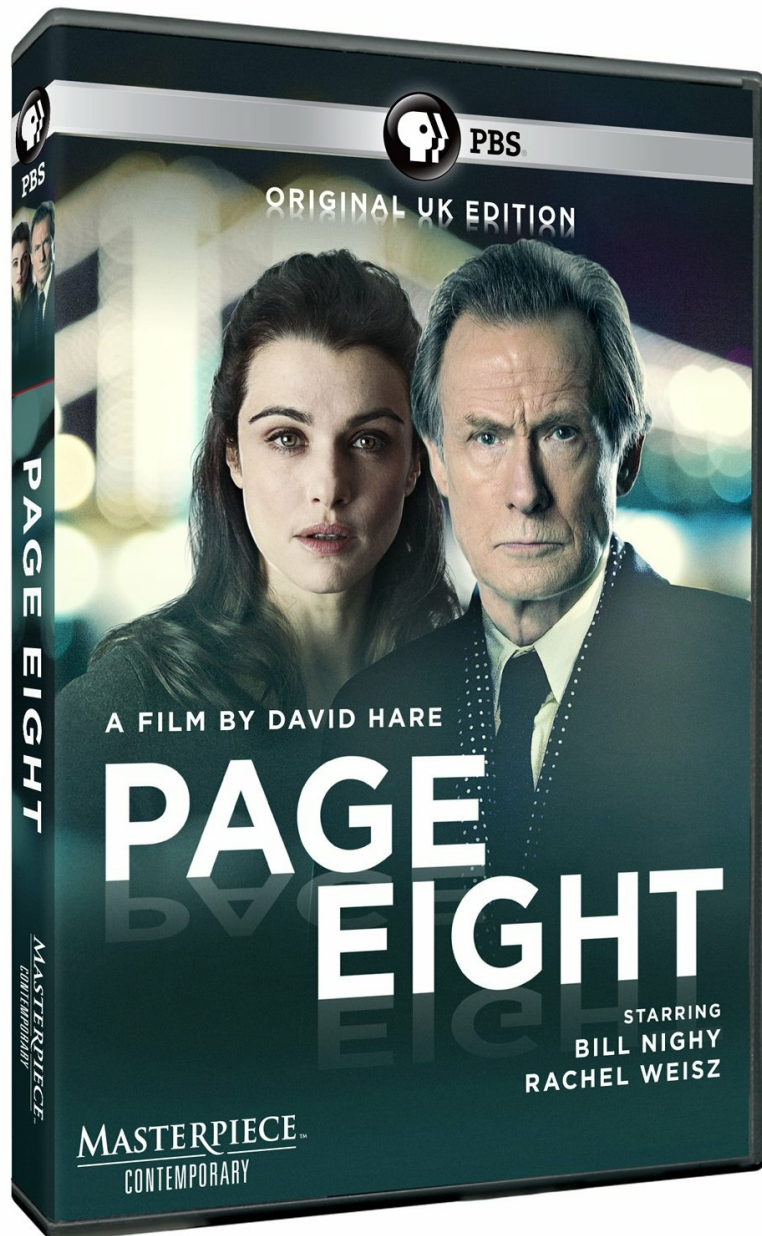

2. SETUP

No audio or video during playback.	Incorrect TV input selected; loose cables; audio/video settings on player.	Verify your TV is on the correct input. Check all audio/video cable connections. Adjust audio/video settings on your DVD player.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Skipping or freezing during playback.	Disc surface damage; dust inside player; player lens dirty.	Clean the disc. If the problem persists, consider using a DVD player lens cleaner or consult your player's manual.
Cannot access menu options or subtitles.	Remote control issues; specific player limitations.	Ensure remote batteries are working. Refer to your DVD player's manual for specific navigation instructions.
