3. INCLUDED COMPONENTS

Your Sauder HomePlus Wardrobe/Pantry Cabinet includes all necessary assembly instructions, hardware, and materials for construction. Please verify all components are present before beginning assembly.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this product. Clear instructions are provided to facilitate quick setup. It is recommended to have two people for certain steps, especially when handling larger components or attaching doors.

4.1. Key Assembly Steps & Tips

- **Review Instructions:** Before starting, carefully read the entire assembly instruction booklet.
- **Clear Workspace:** Ensure you have a clean, spacious area for assembly to prevent damage to components.
- **Component Identification:** Familiarize yourself with all parts and hardware.

Proper attachment of the back panel is crucial for the unit's squareness, stability, and strength. Do not stand the unit upright without the back attached, as it may collapse.

4.6. Adjustable Base Levelers

The cabinet features adjustable base levelers to ensure stability on uneven surfaces. Adjust them as needed to prevent wobbling.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Storage Features

- **Garment Rod:** The upper section behind the framed panel doors includes a garment rod for hanging clothes.
- **Adjustable Shelf:** An adjustable shelf provides flexible storage options for various items.
- **Storage Drawer:** The lower drawer operates on smooth metal runners with safety stops for easy access and secure storage.

5.2. Cord Access

The enclosed back panel includes cord access, allowing for neat management of electrical cords if the cabinet is used to house electronics or appliances.

6. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your cabinet, wipe surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Wobbling Unit:** If the unit wobbles, adjust the base levelers until it is stable on all four corners.
- **Sticking Drawer:** Ensure drawer rails are correctly installed and free of obstructions. Check that all fasteners are tight.
- **Misaligned Doors:** Refer to the assembly instructions for door hinge adjustment procedures to correct any misalignment.




Figure 3: Product dimensions and internal measurements.
