SETUP AND INSTALLATION

MAINTENANCE

For optimal performance, it is recommended to dispose of the microfilter bags after each use, especially when cleaning ultra-fine dirt particles. High-density mesh can become blocked, affecting the vacuum's efficiency.

- After each cleaning session, remove the microfilter bag from the cleaner.
- Carefully empty any collected debris into a waste receptacle.
- As these are disposable microfilter bags, replace with a new bag for subsequent cleanings to ensure maximum filtration efficiency.

- **Blocked Water Flow:** The high-density mesh of the microfilter bags is designed to capture ultra-fine dirt particles. If the bag becomes heavily saturated with these particles, it can block water flow and reduce the vacuum's performance.
- **Solution:** Immediately replace the used microfilter bag with a new one. Regular replacement ensures consistent and effective cleaning.
