INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation and maintenance of your Casio G-Shock GA-100 Series Watch. Designed for durability and precision, this watch features a robust construction with shock and magnetic resistance, 200-meter water resistance, and a range of advanced functions to support various activities.

SETUP GUIDE

Before using your watch, it is essential to set the correct time, date, and other basic configurations. The GA-100 series combines analog and digital displays, requiring specific steps for synchronization.

1. Setting Time and Date

1. Ensure the watch is in Timekeeping Mode. If not, press the **MODE** button repeatedly until the current time and date are displayed.

2. Press and hold the **ADJUST** button (top left) for approximately 3 seconds until the city code starts flashing. This indicates the setting mode.
3. Use the **FORWARD** (bottom right) and **REVERSE** (top right) buttons to select your desired city code (Home City).
4. Press the **MODE** button to cycle through the settings: DST (Daylight Saving Time), 12/24-hour format, Seconds, Hour, Minute, Year, Month, Day, and Light Duration (LT).
5. For each setting, use the **FORWARD** and **REVERSE** buttons to change the values.
6. After setting the time and date, press the **ADJUST** button to exit the setting mode. The watch hands will automatically adjust to the digital time.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your G-Shock GA-100 watch is equipped with multiple modes and functions. Use the **MODE** button to navigate between them.

1. Stopwatch Function

- From Timekeeping Mode, press **MODE** until "STW" (Stopwatch) appears.
- Press **START/STOP** (bottom right) to start and stop the stopwatch.
- Press **SPLIT/RESET** (bottom left) to record split times or reset the stopwatch when stopped.
- The watch features a 1/1000-second stopwatch with speed measurement capabilities.

2. Countdown Timer

- From Timekeeping Mode, press **MODE** until "TMR" (Timer) appears.
- To set the countdown time, hold **ADJUST** until the hour setting flashes. Use **FORWARD/REVERSE** to set.
- Press **MODE** to move between hour and minute settings.
- Press **ADJUST** to confirm.
- Press **START/STOP** to start and stop the countdown.

3. Alarm Function

- From Timekeeping Mode, press **MODE** until "ALM" (Alarm) appears. The GA-100 supports up to five daily alarms.
- Use **FORWARD** to cycle through AL1 to AL5 and SNZ (Snooze Alarm).
- To set an alarm, hold **ADJUST** until the hour setting flashes. Use **FORWARD/REVERSE** to set the hour and minute.
- Press **ADJUST** to confirm.
- To turn an alarm ON/OFF, select the alarm number and press **START/STOP**.

4. World Time

- From Timekeeping Mode, press **MODE** until "WT" (World Time) appears.
- Use **FORWARD** and **REVERSE** to view the current time in 48 cities (29 time zones).

5. Backlight (Auto LED)

- The watch features an Auto LED light. To activate it manually, press the **A.LIGHT** button (top right).
- To enable Auto Light, hold the **A.LIGHT** button for several seconds until "A.LIGHT" appears on the digital display. When enabled, tilting your wrist towards you in a dark environment will automatically illuminate the display.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your G-Shock watch.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a mild soap solution and rinse thoroughly under running water. Ensure all buttons are not pressed while submerged.
- **Water Resistance:** The watch is water resistant to 200 meters. This means it is suitable for showering, swimming, and snorkeling. Avoid operating buttons underwater to prevent water intrusion.
- **Temperature Exposure:** Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures, both hot and cold, as this can affect battery life and accuracy.
- **Battery Replacement:** The watch is powered by a 2-year CR1220 battery. When the display dims or functions become erratic, it's time for a battery replacement. It is recommended to have this done by a qualified technician to maintain water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your watch, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Digital Display is Blank or Dim:** The battery may be low. Replace the CR1220 battery.
- **Analog Hands Do Not Match Digital Time:** Perform a manual hand alignment. In Timekeeping Mode, hold **ADJUST** until the city code flashes, then press **MODE** repeatedly until you reach the hand alignment screen (usually indicated by "H.SET"). Use **FORWARD/REVERSE** to align the hands to 12:00, then press **ADJUST**.
- **Buttons Are Unresponsive:** Ensure the watch is not in a locked mode (if applicable) or that it is not submerged in water. If the issue persists, a reset may be required (refer to the full manual for advanced reset procedures).
- **Inaccurate Time:** Check your Home City setting and DST (Daylight Saving Time) settings. Ensure they are correctly configured for your region.
