3. FITTING AND ADJUSTMENT

Proper fit is crucial for comfort, control, and protection. Follow these guidelines for fitting your boots:

1. **Try On with Riding Socks:** Always try on your boots with the type of socks you typically wear for riding to ensure an accurate fit.
2. **Ensure Proper Sizing:** Your toes should not touch the front of the boot, and your heel should feel secure with minimal lift. The boot should feel snug but not uncomfortably tight.
3. **Secure Fasteners:** Ensure all buckles, straps, or laces are securely fastened. This provides ankle support and prevents the boot from shifting during activity.
4. **Walk Around:** Take a few steps to assess comfort and flexibility. The boots should allow for natural movement while providing necessary support.

4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regular care and maintenance will extend the life of your boots and maintain their protective qualities.

4.1 Cleaning

- **Remove Loose Dirt:** Brush off any loose dirt or debris with a soft brush after each use.

- **Wipe Down:** Use a damp cloth with mild soap and water to wipe down the exterior of the boots. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Rinse Thoroughly:** Rinse with clean water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.
- **Air Dry:** Allow boots to air dry completely in a well-ventilated area away from direct heat or sunlight. Do not use artificial heat sources like hair dryers, as this can damage materials.

4.2 Storage

- Store boots in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Ensure boots are completely dry before storing to prevent mold or mildew growth.

4.3 Maintaining Waterproofing (Hydraguard)

The Hydraguard membrane is designed to be durable. To maintain its performance:

- Avoid puncturing or excessively creasing the boot material, as this can compromise the membrane.
- Periodically treat the exterior material with a suitable waterproofing spray designed for synthetic materials, if recommended by the manufacturer, to enhance water repellency.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Sizing and Fit Issues

- **Boots feel too small:** Ensure you are wearing appropriate riding socks. If the issue persists, consider exchanging for a larger size. Note that some boots may require a break-in period.
- **Boots feel too large:** Ensure all fasteners are tightened. Thicker socks may help. If the boot still feels too loose, consider a smaller size.
- **Discomfort:** Check for pressure points. Ensure socks are not bunched up. If discomfort persists, the sizing or shape may not be suitable for your foot.

5.2 Water Penetration

- Ensure the top of the boot is covered by your riding pants to prevent water from entering from above.
- Inspect the boot for any visible damage or punctures that could compromise the Hydraguard membrane.
