INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Phonocar VM060 Multimedia System. This device is designed to enhance your in-car entertainment and connectivity experience. It features a 6.75-inch HD TFT/LCD capacitive touch screen, DAB+ digital radio, and a USB player. This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your new multimedia system. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure safe and optimal performance.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the Phonocar VM060 multimedia system requires technical knowledge. It is highly recommended to have the unit installed by a professional car audio technician.

General Installation Steps:

1. **Disconnect Battery:** Before starting, disconnect the negative terminal of your vehicle's battery to prevent electrical shorts.
2. **Remove Old Unit:** Carefully remove your existing car radio or blanking plate from the dashboard.
3. **Connect Wiring:** Connect the provided power/speaker harness to the vehicle's wiring loom. Ensure all connections are secure and correctly matched (e.g., constant power, ignition power, ground, speaker outputs).
4. **Connect Accessories:** Connect the USB extension cable, external microphone, GPS antenna (if included),

and RCA cables as needed for your setup.

5. **Mounting:** Secure the VM060 main unit into the dashboard using the supplied mounting frame and brackets.
6. **Test Connections:** Before fully reassembling the dashboard, reconnect the battery and perform a basic function test (power on, radio, sound).
7. **Final Assembly:** Once satisfied with the connections and basic functionality, reassemble the dashboard components.

Phonelink Smartphone Connectivity:

The Phonocar VM060 features a Phonelink function, allowing you to mirror your smartphone screen onto the multimedia system's display via a cable connection.

1. Connect your smartphone to the VM060 using a compatible USB cable.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts on the VM060 to activate the Phonelink function.
3. Ensure your smartphone has the necessary permissions enabled for screen mirroring or USB debugging, as required by your phone's operating system.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off:

- The system typically powers on automatically with the vehicle's ignition.
- To manually power off or put into standby, press and hold the power button (usually a physical button or an icon on the screen).

Touch Screen Operation:

- Navigate menus and select functions by tapping the icons or options on the 6.75-inch capacitive touch screen.

- Swipe gestures may be supported for scrolling through lists or changing screens.

DAB+ Radio:

- Select the "DAB+" source from the main menu.
- The system will automatically scan for available DAB+ stations.
- Browse and select stations from the list.

USB Player:

- Insert a USB drive containing audio or video files into the USB port (or connected extension cable).
- Select the "USB" source from the main menu.
- Browse files and folders on the USB drive using the touch screen.
- Supported audio output mode: Stereo, 2 channels.

Phonelink Function:

- Once your smartphone is connected via USB and Phonelink is activated (as per Setup section), your phone's screen will be mirrored on the VM060 display.
- You can interact with your phone's applications directly from the VM060 touch screen (functionality may vary depending on smartphone model and app compatibility).

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner specifically designed for electronic displays. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **General Cleaning:** Wipe the unit's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid getting liquids inside the unit.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check the Phonocar official website for any available firmware updates for your VM060 model. Follow the instructions carefully for any update process.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Phonocar VM060, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Incorrect wiring, blown fuse, vehicle battery issue.	Check power connections and fuses. Ensure vehicle battery is charged. Consult installer.
No sound	Incorrect speaker wiring, volume too low, mute activated, incorrect audio source.	Verify speaker connections. Increase volume. Check if mute is active. Select correct audio source.
Phonelink not working	Incompatible cable, smartphone settings, app issues.	Use a high-quality USB data cable. Check smartphone's USB connection settings (e.g., USB debugging, file transfer mode). Restart both devices.
Touch screen unresponsive	System freeze, dirt on screen.	Restart the unit (if possible). Clean the screen. If problem persists, contact support.
