INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, care, and maintenance of your Neolight Audio CD. Please read through this guide to ensure optimal enjoyment and longevity of your product.

SETUP

To begin enjoying your Neolight Audio CD, ensure you have a compatible audio playback device. This can include a CD

player, DVD player, Blu-ray player, or a computer with a CD-ROM drive.

- **Inspect the CD:** Before inserting, visually inspect the disc for any visible scratches, smudges, or debris.
- **Clean if necessary:** If smudges are present, gently wipe the disc from the center outwards with a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive materials or circular motions.
- **Open Disc Tray:** Open the disc tray or slot of your playback device.
- **Insert CD:** Carefully place the CD into the tray with the label side facing up. Ensure it is seated correctly.
- **Close Disc Tray:** Close the disc tray or push the CD fully into the slot.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the CD is loaded, your playback device should recognize it automatically. Follow these general steps to play the audio content:

1. **Power On:** Ensure your audio playback device and connected speakers/headphones are powered on.
2. **Select Source:** If your device has multiple inputs, select the correct source (e.g., "CD" or "Disc").
3. **Play:** Press the "Play" button on your device or remote control. The audio content should begin playing.
4. **Navigation:** Use the "Next Track," "Previous Track," "Pause," and "Stop" buttons to control playback as desired.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life of your Neolight Audio CD and ensure consistent playback quality.

- **Handling:** Always hold the CD by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface.
- **Cleaning:** For dust or fingerprints, gently wipe the disc with a soft, lint-free cloth (e.g., microfiber) from the center hub straight out to the edge. Do not wipe in circular motions. For stubborn marks, a slightly dampened cloth with water can be used, followed by immediate drying with a dry cloth.
- **Storage:** Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Do not stack CDs without protection. Avoid dropping the CD or placing it on rough surfaces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing your Neolight Audio CD, consider the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
CD does not play or is not recognized.	◦ Ensure the CD is inserted correctly (label side up). ◦ Check if the disc is clean and free of smudges or deep scratches. ◦ Try playing another audio CD to confirm your player is functioning correctly. ◦ Restart your playback device.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Audio skips or stutters.	◦ Clean the disc thoroughly as described in the Maintenance section. ◦ Check for visible scratches on the playback surface. Deep scratches may cause permanent skipping. ◦ Ensure the playback device is on a stable surface to prevent vibrations. ◦ Try playing the CD in a different player to isolate the issue.
No sound.	◦ Check the volume level on your playback device and connected speakers/headphones. ◦ Ensure all audio cables are securely connected. ◦ Verify that the correct audio input source is selected on your receiver/amplifier.
