TarBar Cigarette Filters Instruction Manual

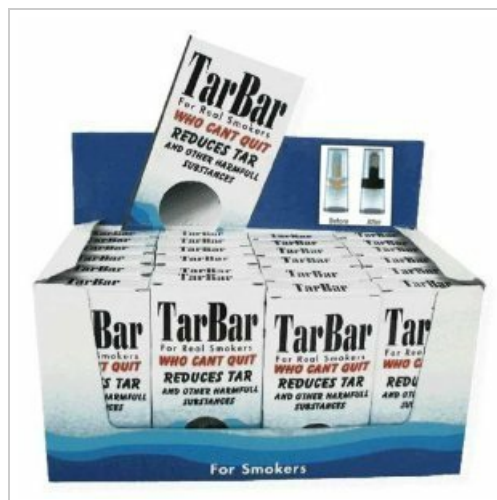

1. INTRODUCTION

The TarBar Cigarette Filters are designed to reduce the amount of tar and other substances inhaled during cigarette smoking. These filters are an accessory intended for use with standard cigarettes. This manual provides instructions for proper use, maintenance, and general information regarding the product.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

TarBar Cigarette Filters are small, clear attachments made from Cellulose Acetate, a plant-based material. When attached to a cigarette, the filter traps a portion of the tar and other particulate matter before it reaches the user. Each display box contains 24 packs, totaling 720 individual filters.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Remove one TarBar filter from its packaging.
2. Gently push the filter onto the mouthpiece end of a standard cigarette. Ensure a snug fit to prevent air leakage.
3. The cigarette is now ready for use.

Once the filter is attached, use the cigarette as normal. The filter will begin to collect tar and other substances, which will become visible within the clear plastic. The effectiveness of the filter may diminish over time as it becomes saturated.

- **Usage Duration:** Each TarBar filter is typically effective for 3 to 7 cigarettes, depending on individual smoking habits and cigarette type.
- **Filter Replacement:** Replace the filter when the internal chamber appears significantly discolored or when resistance to drawing air increases. Continued use of a saturated filter may reduce its effectiveness.

5. MAINTENANCE

TarBar Cigarette Filters are designed for single-use or limited multi-use as described in the operating instructions. They are not intended for cleaning or reuse beyond their recommended capacity.

- **Disposal:** Dispose of used filters responsibly in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
- **Storage:** Store unused filters in their original packaging in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Difficulty Drawing Air:** If you experience increased resistance when drawing air through the filter, it likely indicates the filter is saturated with tar and needs to be replaced.
- **Loose Fit:** If the filter does not fit snugly on the cigarette, try adjusting its position or ensure you are using it with a standard-sized cigarette.
