## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The EnviroCare Replacement Tower HEPA Vacuum Filters are designed to provide superior filtration for Kenmore Progressive Bagless Uprights and compatible Panasonic Commercial bagless vacuum models. These filters are crucial for maintaining the performance of your vacuum cleaner and ensuring a cleaner home environment by trapping microscopic particles and allergens.

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

---

Proper installation of your new EnviroCare HEPA filter is essential for optimal vacuum performance and air filtration. Always refer to your specific vacuum cleaner's user manual for detailed instructions on accessing and replacing the filter compartment.

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your vacuum cleaner is unplugged from the power outlet before beginning any maintenance or installation.
2. **Locate Filter Compartment:** Identify the filter compartment on your Kenmore Progressive Bagless Upright or compatible Panasonic Commercial bagless vacuum. This is typically located near the dust bin or motor housing.
3. **Remove Old Filter:** Carefully open the compartment and remove the old, dirty filter. Dispose of the old filter according to local regulations.
4. **Insert New Filter:** Place the new EnviroCare Replacement Tower HEPA Filter into the compartment. Ensure it is seated correctly and securely. Some models may require a slight push to fit snugly. *Note: One customer review mentioned a tight fit with the provided foam rubber gasket, requiring a firm push.*
5. **Close Compartment:** Close the filter compartment securely. Ensure all latches or covers are properly fastened.
6. **Test Vacuum:** Plug in your vacuum cleaner and perform a brief test to ensure it operates normally and suction is restored.

## OPERATING CONSIDERATIONS

---

Once installed, the EnviroCare HEPA filter works continuously to capture fine dust, pet dander, pollen, and other airborne allergens as your vacuum operates. For best results, ensure your vacuum's dust bin is emptied regularly to prevent excessive strain on the filter and maintain consistent suction power.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

While these are replacement filters, some users have found methods to extend their life. Please note that filter lifespan can vary based on usage and environment.

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check the filter for visible dirt and debris buildup. A heavily soiled filter can reduce vacuum efficiency.
- **Cleaning (Optional):** Some users report success cleaning these filters with compressed air or a smaller vacuum to remove loose debris. For a deeper clean, they can be washed in soapy water with a small amount of bleach, then thoroughly dried before reinstallation. *Ensure the filter is completely dry before placing it back into the vacuum to prevent mold or damage.*
- **Replacement Frequency:** For optimal performance and air quality, it is recommended to replace your HEPA filter every 6 to 12 months, or more frequently if you have pets, allergies, or use your vacuum extensively.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues after installing your new filter, consider the following:

- **Filter Not Fitting:** Double-check that you have the correct filter model for your vacuum. Refer to the compatible models listed in the specifications. If it feels too tight, ensure it's aligned correctly and apply firm, even pressure. Avoid forcing it if it doesn't align.
- **Reduced Suction:**
  - Ensure the filter is installed correctly and the compartment is sealed.
  - Check for blockages in the hose, brush roll, or dust bin.
  - The dust bin may be full and needs emptying.
- **Unusual Noises:** Verify the filter is securely in place and not vibrating. Check for any loose parts in the vacuum.
